I. OBJECTIVE

- 1) To consult with community fisheries and fisheries administration cantonment to collect data and GPS Points to draw a map of Marine Fisheries Management Area in Kampot province under the support of SEAFDEC/UNEP/GEF.

II. INVOLVED PERSON

- 2) There are 4 fisheries administration officers participating in the field trip in Kampot province to consult with member of Community Fisheries Committee and Fisheries Administration Cantonment in Kampot to produce a map of MFMA, naming as follow:
 - Mr. Ouk Vibol, Director of Department of Fisheries Conservation and National Focal Point
 - Mr. Leng Sy Vann, Deputy Director of Department of Fisheries Conservation and National Scientific and Technical Focal Point
 - Mr. Kim Sokha, Chief of Division of Fisheries Conservation
 - Ms. Va Sotepi, Officer of the Department of Fisheries Conservation

III. FIELD TRIP ACTIVITIES

3.1 Consultation with Fisheries Administration Cantonment Teamwork led by **Mr. Ouk Vibol** met and discussed with Fisheries Administration Cantonment in Kampot on data and GPS Points collection to prepare a map of MFMA in Kampot province in term of sustainable marine fisheries resource management in Kampot province, especially sea grass, coral reef and mangrove forest. (See Annex 1, 2 and 3)

- 4) **Mr. Ouk Vibol** suggested **Mr. Voeun Seila** help do this work with teamwork from FiA and he added that how to collect the piece of data and from which point.
- 5) **Mr. Voeun Seila** informed that he accepted that proposal and Fisheries Administration Cantonment is also available of some data related to mapping such as three community fisheries data. However, it is needed to collect more data from field work to produce a proper map for MFMA in Kampot.

3.2 Consultation with Community Fisheries

- 6) Teamwork led by Mr. Ouk Vibol met and discuss with three community fisheries (CF) located in Trapaing Roupav village, Prek Thaot village, and Chorng Hoan village, Tek Chhou district, Kampot province, which are that site selected for MFMA establishment.
- 7) The purpose of discussion is to collect detailed data related to selected site for MFMA establishment, including a provincial development plan at that sites and the identification of protected zone, conservation zone, *refugia* zone, and eco-tourism zone in MFMA.
- 8) Community Fisheries agreed to create MFMA in community fisheries area to ensure that marine fisheries resource is protected and managed well, especially sea grass, coral reef, and mangrove forest, which are spawning habitat for fish species in particular Grouper.
- 9) Community Fisheries also agreed to work with FiAC and FiA in the preparation of MFMA map to ensure that marine fisheries in Kampot are quarantined by law.

3.3 Site Visit and Collect GPS Point for Mapping

- 10) Teamwork collaborated with CFi and FiAC to visit site to collect data and GPS points for mapping of MFMA starting from Koh Touch commune to the border of Vinh Hour Port. GPS points were recorded from Protected Zone, Conservation Zone, Fisheries Refugia Zone, and Eco-Tourism Zone. (See Annex 4):

IV. CONCLUSION

- 11) Fisheries Administration Cantonment in Kampot and Community Fisheries agreed FiA's proposal to produce MFMA's map to ensure sustainable marine fisheries resource management in Kampot, especially sea grass, coral reef, and mangrove forest, which are critical habitat for feeding, spawning and nursery of fish species such as Grouper.
