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1. OPENING WORKSHOP

- The stakeholder consultation workshop for MFMA's management plan preparation in Kep was organized by Fisheries Administration (FiA) of Cambodia collaborating with Kep Fisheries Administration Cantonment from 19th to 20th September 2018, funded by SEAFDEC/UNEP/GEF Fisheries *Refugia* Project. The workshop was conducted at Palm House Boutique in Kep, participating 25 people from the FiA, Department of Agriculture, Forestry, and Fisheries, Fisheries Administration Cantonment, Community Fisheries, and MCC. (see annex 1 and 2).
- 2) Mr. Theng Borin, Director of Department of Agriculture, Forestry, and Fisheries welcomed to all participants and expressed thanks very much for Mr. Ouk Vibol, Director of Department of Fisheries Conservation helping to organize that workshop. He added that he suggested participants to give ideas into the MFMA management plan in order to submit to Technical Working Group, which is a compass to manage sustainable marine fisheries resource. On behalf of Kep Administration and Fisheries Administration Cantonment, I thanked participants again for their participations in the two days workshop.
- 3) **Mr. Ouk Vibol** thanked Director of Department of Agriculture, Forestry, and Fisheries very much for his participation today, Director of Fisheries Administration Cantonment, Paul Ferber, Deputy Director of the Department from FiA, and Community Fisheries in Kep. He added that the goal of MFMA establishment is to ensure sustainable marine fisheries resource management for next generation. Therefore, there were two things needing to do on upcoming, including MFMA management plan preparation and an extension working.
- 4) Mr. Ouk Vibol informed that there will be budgets coming from SEAFDEC, MCC, IUCN, and FiA for an extension working in MFMA. Those budgets will be used to produce extension materials such as posters and leaflets at local community around MFMA area. He hoped that MCC will provide some budgets to do an extension working in MFMA, so would Fisheries Administration Cantonment please raised budgets to do that job.

2. DISCUSSION ON MFMA'S MANAGEMENT PLAN GOAL

5) MFMA's Management Plan Goal from discussion is "marine fisheries resource and ecology system improved through effective management, promoting eco-tourism and adopting climate resilience of community, and contributing to local livelihood".

3. DISCUSSION ON MFMA'S MANAGEMENT OBJECTIVES AND ACTION

- 6) MFMA's Objectives and Actions from discuss are delineated as follow:
 - a) 1st objective is "to strengthen law and regulation enforcement to crack down illegal fishing and other offenses effectively". There are 4 actions including 1) establishment of Taskforce from relevant stakeholders to crack down illegal fishing activities; 2) provision of resources and equipments to strengthen an effective patrolling; 3) law enforcement to delete IUU; and 4) preparation and implementation of rules and regulations required for MFMA's management;
 - b) 2nd objective is "to *improve critical habitat restorations and protections to ensure fisheries resource stock in the nature*". There are 4 actions including 1) identification and boundary demarcation of main fisheries management zones in MFMA; 2) construction and deploying of concrete boxes or other devices to create artificial reef and prevent all kinds of trawling vessels; 3) habitat restoration such as sea grass, coral reef, and mangrove forest; and 4) establishment and Implementation of monitoring program on the effectiveness of an artificial reef deploying;
 - c) 3rd objective is "to build capacity and raise awareness of local communities and other relevant stakeholders on Koh Tonsay Marine Fisheries Management Area, fisheries

resources and valuable marine ecosystem". There are 3 actions including 1) assessment on capacity building needs and stakeholder analysis; 2) implementation of capacity building and knowledge exchange; and 3) information dissemination on the MFMA, related legislations, fisheries resources and valuable marine ecosystem;

- d) 4th objective is "to *improve and diversify the livelihoods of the local community fisheries in order to reduce the pressure on fisheries resources*". There are 3 actions including 1) assessment on possible alternative livelihood needs; 2) implement pilot alternative livelihood program; and 3) Research and implement Tourism User Fees;
- e) 5th objective is "to conduct effective and continuous monitoring of Koh Tonsayand Koh Por Archipelago MFMA". There are 5 actions including 1) review and documentation of existing information on habitats and fisheries resource within MFMA; 2) assess the MFMA unstudied ecosystem to support the development of tailored management strategies; 3) conduct subsequent monitoring of critical ecosystems of the MFMA (seagrass, benthic, coral reefs); 4) assess endangered species knowledge gaps, to support the development of tailored management strategies; 5) assess commercials species knowledge gaps, and establish monitoring programme to support the development of tailored management strategies supporting the sustainable use of marine resources within the MFMA;
- f) 6th objective is "to strengthen the collaboration within local relevant authorities and stakeholders in order to have better integrated management mechanism". There are 3 actions including 1) establishment and operationalization of the Provincial Management Committee for Kep MFMA; 2) establishment and operationalization of the Technical Working group for Kep MFMA; and 3) Integrate MFMA management plan into provincial and commune investment plan;
- g) 7th objective is "to strengthen cooperation between the two provinces of Kep and Kian Giang in the fields of biodiversity conservation and sustainable use of resources". There are two actions including 1) initiate bilateral agreements between two provinces; and 2) establish information sharing mechanism between Kep and Kian Giang;
- h) 8th objective is "to significantly reduce pollution and improve water quality management within the KohTonsay and Koh Por Archipelago MFMA". There are 4actions including 1) monitor and set guidelines for the natural range of water quality parameters within the MFMA; 2) monitor and reduce human activities that deteriorate ecosystem within MFMA;
 3) install innovative systems to improve water quality; and 4) educational programs on reducing pollution; and
- i) 9th objective is "to ensure sustainable funding for the effective management of the MFMA".
