  - b) Conservation Zone of 30ha in Chhorng Horn CFI is with UTM Point :
    - 058 X=390929, Y=1167203
    - 059 X=390811, Y=1167598
  - c) Fisheries *Refugia* Zone of 500ha from Thmor Kapal Bek to Try Pheap Company is with UTM Point:
    - 060 X=390275, Y=1167490
  - d) Dolphin Conservation Zone of 40ha from Krolok Kontan Karng Tboung in Chhorng Horn CFI is with UTM Point:
    - 061 X=388899, Y=1167928
    - 062 X=388988, Y=1168839
