#### 1. Open meeting

- 1) 2nd Technical Working Group meeting was organized by Fisheries Administration (FiA) of Cambodia collaborating with Kep Provincial Hall Administration and Kep Fisheries Administration Cantonment on 29 April 2019 funded by SEAFDEC/UNEP/GEF Fisheries Refugia. The meeting was conducted at Kep Provincial Hall Administration and was attended by 31 total participants from Fisheries Administration, Fisheries Administration Cantonment in Kampot, Department of Environment, Department of Tourism, Department of Land, Construction and Cadastral, Department of Public Works and Transports, Maritime Police 241, and Communities Fisheries (see Annex 1, 2 &3).
- 2) Mr. Prom Kunti, Deputy Governor of Kep welcomed to all Technical Working Group and informed that today is 2<sup>nd</sup> TWG meeting and the 1<sup>st</sup> meeting is on 16-17 November 2018. We had also the retreatment meeting on 22 February 2019 in order to review the draft management plan for MFMA before meeting with TWG this morning. Therefore the 2<sup>nd</sup> TWG meeting is important in reviewing the draft management plans for MFMA in Kep before submission this document to Provincial Management Committee co-chaired by Kep Governor and Director General of Fisheries Administration for approval and signature (see annex 1 and 2).
- 3) Mr. Ouk Vibol, Director of Department of Fisheries Conservation, expressed thanks to Mr. Prom Kunti, Deputy Governor of Kep and Technical Working Group from provincial line departments, taking their opportunity to join that meeting. There are three activities needing to do as follow:
  - Review 3 year management plan for MFMA in Kep before submission this document to Kep Governor and Director General of Fisheries Administration for approval and signature.
  - Monitor MCC works to be implemented in the past and MCC's next plan
  - Extension working done by Kep FiAC and next plan

#### 2. Presentation of draft 5 year management plan for MFMA in Kep

4) Mr. Ouk Vibol presented draft 5 year-management plan for MFMA to TWG meeting for checking and reviewing it and he suggested the meeting to review and correct each paragraph, especially Kep provincial hall administration's Logo and Kep Governor's Preface.

#### 3. Discussion draft 3 year management plan for MFMA in Kep

- 5) Mr. Prom Kunti suggested meeting to discussing that management plan
- 6) The meeting agreed cover page, Logo and Kep Governor's preface, acknowledgement, and content, however the meeting corrected Kep Governor's preface such as environmental sustainable city, competition movement, clean land and water, and provincial administration.
- 7) The meeting also revised point 1.3.2 and 1.3.4, and proposed Kep FiAC to check and correct Table 3, 4, and 5 in the management plan (see 5 year-management plan for MFMA in Kep from 2019-2021).
- 8) **Mr. Ouk Vibol** continued to present the MFMA in Kep's action plan and budget plan of US dollar accounting for 618,720. However so far there are some budgets in hand for the implementation of working activities such as US dollar 100,000 from FiA; US dollar 100,000 from MCC; US dollar 70,000 from Fisheries *Refugia* Project SEAFDEC/UNEP/GEF; US dollar 30,000 from FiAC in Kep; US dollar 40,000 from EU; and other budget from FAO and FACT.
- 9) Mr. Lou Vanny suggested inserting budget into each objective
- 10) Mr. Prom Kunti proposed to review and add the MAFF's proclamation, Provincial Management Committee, and Technical Working Group Committee into Appendix as well. He requested a meeting to review and correct it and sends it back to provincial administration for the period of 3 days for compilation; however it is needed to have a retreat meeting for

- altogether discussion to ensure that documents more and more better before the document approved and signed by Kep Governor and Director General of Fisheries Administration.
- 11) Mr. Ouk Vibol also raised some experiences in Koh Rong, Preah Sihanouk Vill province. Hotels and Guest Houses increase their room/accommodation price from US dollar 1-2 for conservation works, so both national and international clients are happy to contribute to natural resource conservation.
- 12) Ms. Khem Vouch ly responded that today the Koh Tonsay Association gets bidding the tax on goods from provincial administration.
- 13) Mr. Ouk Vibol proposed the Association to discuss with Chairperson of Meeting to coordinate that work.
- 14) Ms. Khem Vouch Iy requested the working discussion connecting the budget with the Association, enabling the association to have enough budgets for conservation works.
- 15) Mr. Ouk Vibol expects that it will be available of dolphin next time.

#### 4. MCC's presentation on Strategies of Concrete Block Deploying and Next Plan

- 16) Mr. Tom Collombat presented about strategy of deploying concrete block in order to restore Kep Archipelago better, especially MFMA in Koh Po and Koh Tonsay Archipelago through illegal fishing reduction, increasing in fish population, and key habitat protection such as sea grass and coral reef. Main locations are selected to deploy such as sea grass and high biodiversity rich areas around koh Mak Prang, Koh Ses, and Koh Ang Krong. So far 80 artificial reefs (1600 concrete blocks) have been deployed into MFMA in Koh Po and Koh Tonsay Archipelago. However, there are some problems facing such as illegal fishing vessels and irregular weather and as the case block clusters are built to install along water surface, but uncommon people have come to cut these material at night.
- 17) Then he also showed MCC next plan as following: a) MCC still continue to protect sea grass around Koh Po and Koh Tonsay; b) MCC will work closely with Dophin Teamwork to seek and identify specific area for Dolphin protection; c) MCC will work with partnerships and community fisheries to understand clearly about the good location selection for concrete block deploying, and d) MCC will seek more budget from partnerships to build and deploy artificial reef.

#### 5. Presentation of Extension Working by FiAC in Kep

- 18) Mr. Kyng Sophanny presented extension working in MFAM and Fisheries Refugia sites in Kep in order to promote fishermen, community fisheries, and local authorities to know about the importance of MFMA and demarcating the boundaries of MFMA. There are 150 participants from local authorizes, police post, maritime police department, and community fisheries that is located in Sangkhat Kep, Kep city, Kep province attending that meetings. However there is still having some problems due to limited participants and their knowledge, so it is needed to promote extension works offend.
- 19) Mr. Kao Monnirith proposed to invite Navy to attend next meeting, if extension work will be conduct next time.
- 20) Mr. Ouk Vibol requested CFi to assist its promotion furthermore

#### 6. Close meeting

21) Mr. Prom Kunti thanked very much to Technical Working Group, taking their opportunities to join that meeting today. He suggested TWG to check and review draft documents of 5 year plan management plan for MFMA and Fisheries Refugia and send it back to Kep provincial hall administration by 4 May 2019. He proposed to have a retreat meeting to finalize a document before the document submission to H.E Kep Governor and H.E Director General Fisheries Administration for approval and signature. The meeting closed at 5:30pm
