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#### REPORT OF THE MEETING

1. Consultation meeting on the preparation for financial audit of the project entitled "Establishment and Operation of a Regional System of Fisheries Refugia in the South China Sea and Gulf of Thailand" was conducted at Marine Fisheries Research and Development Division, Department of Fisheries (DOF) on 7<sup>th</sup>March 2019. It was aimed to discuss and provide understanding on the format and details of financial reports required for audit. The meeting was chaired by Ms. Praulai Nootmorn, Senior Expert in Marine Fisheries, as National Focal Point for Thailand, and participated by other 8 corresponding personnel, listed as followed:

#### **Conclusion of the Meeting**

- 2. **Mr. Weerasak Yingyuad**, Technical Coordinator for Fisheries Refugia Project, presented to the meeting the summary of 2017- 2018 expenditures for Thailand which was usable for references. The expense summary was itemized in to 4 project components together with their activities, including their sub-total and total amounts of budget allocations and expenditures, as shown in annex 1.
- 3. **Mr. Weerasak** introduced the format of financial report which was categorized by components, activities, and UNEP budget lines. The report consisted of 4 parts: statement of net assets, statement of revenues and expenditures, schedules of expenditures, and details of activities expenditures, as shown in annex 2.
- 4. There followed a discussion regarding the preparation for audit including financial reports, payment vouchers, ledgers, and other needed financial documents.
