**MAIN POINTS:**

- a) Regional Cooperation sub-division of Bureau of Public Relation and International Cooperation MMAF, will communicate to Secretary General of SEAFDEC regarding organizational structure of fisheries *refugia* project

- b) Secretary of AMFRHR, as Chair of the NFRC will immediately issue a decree to appoint Head of Research Institute for Fish Enhancement, Dr. Joni Haryadi as NFP and Research Group Leader, Mr. Ngurah N. Wiadnyana as NSTFP
- c) Director of Research Centre for Fisheries Chair of the NSTC requested that the planning of research be carried out carefully based on the input from the experts commanded by Prof. Ngurah N. Wiadnyana as NSTFP
- d) The implementing team (Astri et al.) will draft a technical guide for then implementation of activities and will be discussed in the next NFRC meeting (third week of July)
- e) The mechanism for implementing activities must refer to all applicable rules in Indonesia, especially at the MMAF.
