### Highlights of Activities

- 1) Two enumerators were assigned each sampling sites in Coron, Palawan They are collecting fish landing data in selected fisheries landing sites in each area.
- 2) Data collected includes gathering and collection of production data by boat by landing center; Identification of fish species caught by gear type; gathering and collection of catch per unit effort by gear by landing center; length and weight data by species by gear; and transcribe other relevant information in relation to the Fisheries Refugia project.
- 3) A total of 422 fishing vessels landed their catch during July to September of 2017 in Coron, Palawan with a total catch of 24,834.80 metric tons. Enumerators also collected length data during the sampling. A total of 10,699.00 fish of different species was measured by the enumerators during the 3 months sampling.
- 4) It was observed that 10 different fishing gears were used in fishing in Coron, Palawan. The table below (Table 1) shows the landing center, fishing gear used, month of fishing and number of boats unloaded per fishing gear as well as the total unloaded catch per gear type and landing center. The table also included the length frequency sampled by fishing gear;
