**1. FIELD TRIP OBJECTIVE**

- 1) To collect way point at Chhorng Horn village, Prek Thnaot commune, Tek Chhou District, Kampot province, funded from SEAFDEC/UNEP/GEF.

**2. INVOLVED PERSONS**

- 2) The field trip was attended by Teamwork from the Department of Fisheries Conservation of Fisheries Administration collaborating with Kampot Fisheries Administration Cantonment, Prek Thnoat Commune, and Chhorng Horn Community Fisheries (see Annex 1).

**3. FIELD TRIP ACTIVITIES****3.1 Discussion with Local Authority and FiAC**

- 3) Teamwork from Department of Fisheries Conservation discussed with Prek Thnaon Commune Chief and Kampot FiAC. The purpose of discussion was to know about the location and the size of impact proposed by company.
- 4) According to the meeting, the location of Company development is in Chhorng village, Prek Thnaot commune, Tek Chhou district, Kampot province and the company will plan development to cover in the size of the 2km in width and 6km in length (See Annex 3).
- 5) The meeting agreed to cut out the water area of the company development overlapping with the marine fisheries management area and draw the new map of marine fisheries management area after taking out the water area of the company development plan.
- 6) The new map will be submitted and consulted with provincial authority again to ensure that the map of marine fisheries management area will be no problem with company development and supported by the provincial hall administration

**3.2 Way Point Collection at the Site of Company Development**

- 7) After discussion meeting, the Teamwork from DFC collaborating with FiAC and Community Fisheries visited the site of company development in Chhorng Horn village, Prek Thnaot commune, Tek Chhou district, Kampot province, and collected way point at that site. The result of way point collection was shown in below table (See Annex 3):
