CHAPTER 1: BACKGROUND

The fisheries sector in Southeast Asia is critical, contributing to people's social, economic, and livelihoods. The several ASEAN Member States were the top ten seafood producers exporting to the world seafood-market during the past decades and even now. However, the challenges on the international fish-trade related issues, particularly the IUU fishing issues, have significantly impacted the ASEAN seafood exporting until the present. In 2015, all ASEAN Member States (AMSs) requested SEAFDEC to develop the ASEAN Catch Documentation Scheme (ACDS) to enhance a traceability system for fish and fisheries products in the ASEAN. SEAFDEC, through the technical consultations with all Member Countries, drafted the ACDS concept in 2015-17, the ASEAN adopted the ACDS concept in May 2017.

To support the implementation of the ACDS, SEAFDEC Training Department (SEAFDEC/TD) has developed the 1st version of the electronic system of the ACDS (eACDS-V.1) in collaboration with a pilot country, Brunei Darussalam, in 2017-2018. The prototype eACDS covers the management of the Catch Declaration (CD), Movement Document (MD), and issuance of Catch Certification (CC). However, the catch reporting at sea was the fundamental problem when mobile devices operated offshore without an internet signal. There was no monitoring system on how raw-fish materials were used in the processing plants and no vessel tracking functions. For these reasons, from 2019 till the 3rd quarter of 2020, SEAFDEC/TD has improved the eACDS applications in collaboration with the Directorate of Fisheries (D-Fish) of Viet Nam. Based on the lesson learned from the existing paper-types of the Viet Nam Catch Certification for EU-Market, SEAFDEC developed the 2nd version of the eACDS (eACDS-V.2) through closed collaboration with the Sub D-Fish in Binh Thuan Province.

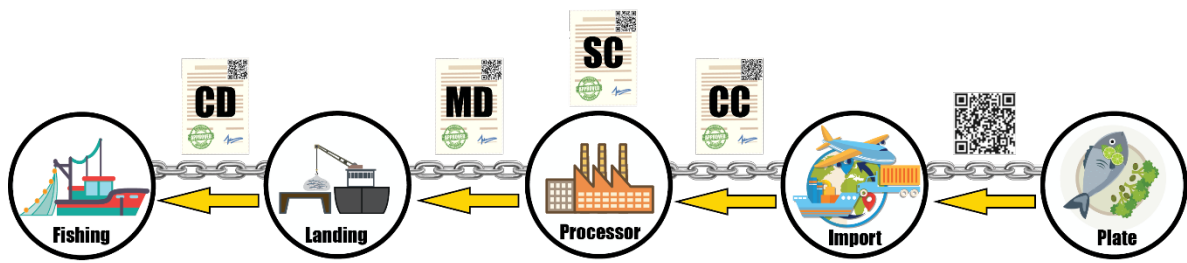


Figure 1-1: Traceability System for Marine Capture Fisheries

The eACDS-V.2 application are to replace the eACDS-V.1 as a new prototype application for further promotion in the ASEAN. The new eACDS system includes mobile application in both online and offline modes for catch reporting at sea, which is a part of the catch declaration process. The 2nd version also added other critical functions on traceability called the Statement of Catch (SC) for monitoring the use of raw-fish materials in the processing plant, as shown in **Figure 1-1**. The system also includes the transshipment at sea and many new features in the applications, such as vessel tracking on the eACDS mobile application, timeline activities recording, summary report, a dashboard for the manager, *etc.*

The ASEAN Catch Documentation Scheme (ACDS) is a management tool to prevent the entry of fish and fishery products from IUU fishing to the supply chains in the ASEAN. Towards the improvement of the traceability system for marine capture fisheries, the manual's overall objective of the ASEAN Catch Documentation Schemes' electronic system is to guide relevant stakeholders along the supply chains to understand the step-by-step how to implement the eACDS applications.:

The eACDS User's Manual consists of six (6) parts described along with traceability system processes from catching to landing, purchasing, transferring of catch to processing, using raw materials in processing, issuing the certification, and exportation. Besides, some countries in the ASEAN region implement transshipment at sea. The eACDS applications, therefore, include the at sea transshipment in a separate part. There are six (6) parts of the manual as follows:

- Part 1: Introduction of the eACDS
- Part 2: Catch Declaration (CD)
- Part 3: Movement Document (MD)
- Part 4: Statement of Catch (SC) and Catch Certification (CC)
- Part 5: Transshipment at Sea
- Part 6: System Administration

Refers to the User's Manual Part: 1, the Key Data Elements (KDEs) used in the eACDS system, this manual concerns the data management and administration of the system. Many sets of the database required proper management to run smoothly the eACDS application such as data set of fish species, fishing port, registered vessels including fishing vessels and other vessel types, fishery product codes, user's list including fishermen, buyers, boat owners, etc. In addition, administration of the eACDS system is also needed for all relevant users accessing to the system. The access levels for each type of users needs to be arranged by the system administrator. This manual will guide the information technology officer or the system administrator to manage the eACDS database, and overall system.

CHAPTER 2: DATA MANAGEMENT

- ✓ The key user for data management shall be a fishery officer or IT officer who has knowledge on both information technology and fisheries.

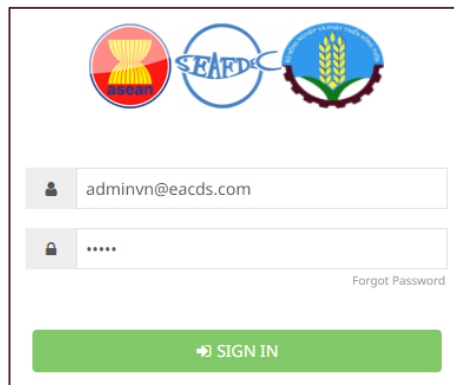


Figure 2-1: Login Page of the eACDS Application

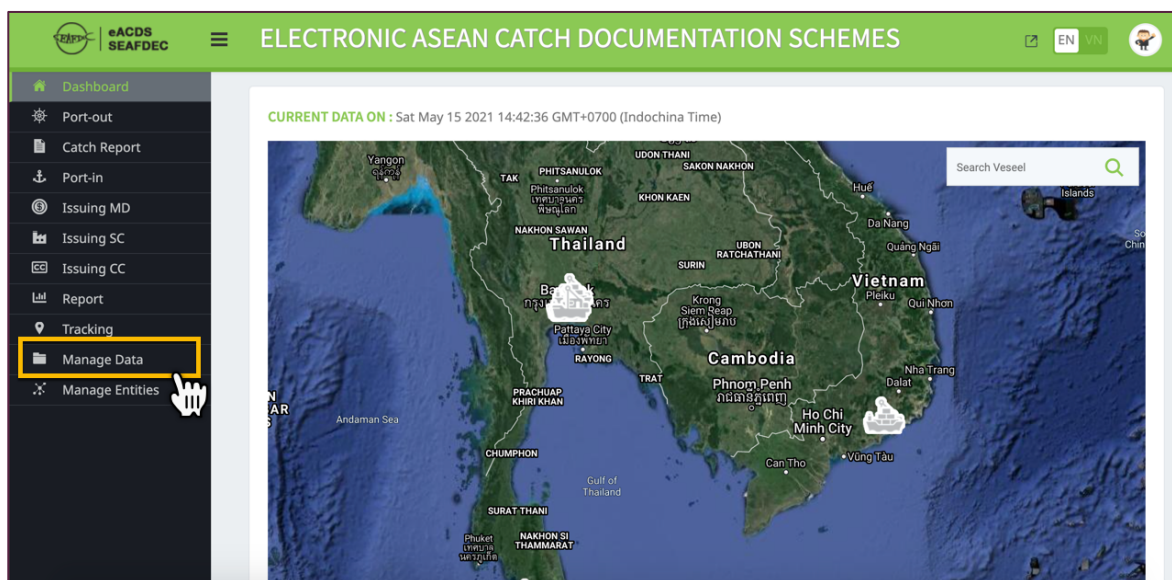


Figure 2-2: Manage Data Menu appears on the Main page of the eACDS Application

- ✓ The user can access to the data management via the eACDS webpage or the URL <https://eacds.seafdec.org/country>. For example, the author uses the eACDS for Viet Nam, so the URL is <https://eacds.seafdec.org/vietnam>, as shown in **Figure 2-1** and **Figure 2-2**.

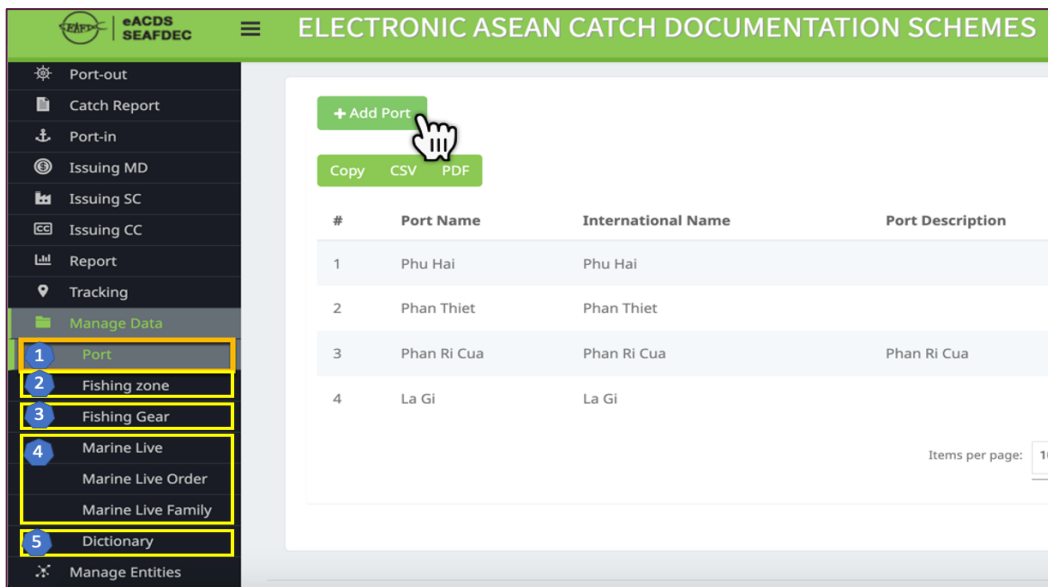


Figure 2-3: Five (5) sub-menus under the Manage Data Menu.

- ✓ From **Figure 2-2**, clicking “Manage Data” menu, the sub-menu will appear as shown in **Figure 2-3**. There are five (5) sub-menus as follows:
 - 1) **Port**: including list of fishing port, international name, and its address information. All fishing port related to port-in and port out should be recorded in this database.
 - 2) **Fishing Zone**: including list of fishing or management zones within the Executive Economic Zone (EEZs). All fishing zones or management zones,

defined by country and recorded during requesting for port out, are recorded in this database.

- 3) **Fishing Gear:** including list of fishing gears, specification, license validation.
- 4) **Marine Live** by species, orders, and family: including all economically species, and some endanger species by species, orders and family.
- 5) **Dictionary:** this part shows all english words or phrases used in the eACDS application. The user can translate each word or phrase into the country language. This function will create a bilanguages eACDS application.

CHAPTER 2-1: PORT

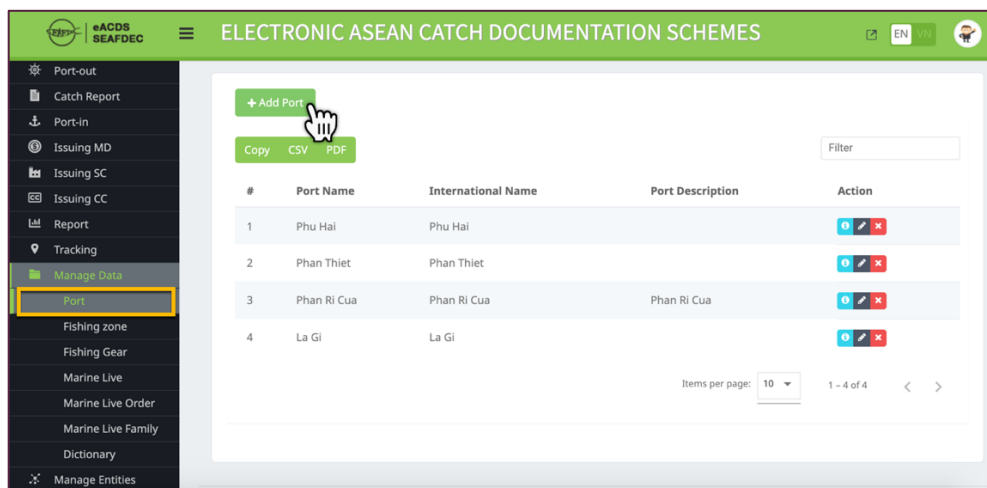


Figure 2-4: Port Database under the Manage Data Menu.

- ✓ From “Manage Data” menu, click on “Port” sub-menu, the main window will appear as **Figure 2-4**.

- ✓ To add a new port by clicking “Add Port” icon, a new template for input a port information such as name, international name, port description, port stamp, address, telephone and facsimile/fax number, and email will appear as **Figure 2-5**.
- ✓ After all information input, click “save”, the system will record all port information under a new port name.
- ✓ Admin can view all recorded information by click “information” icon, a new window will appear as shown in **Figure 2-6**. In addition, admin also can edit the port information by click “Edit” icon.

CHAPTER 2-2: FISHING ZONE

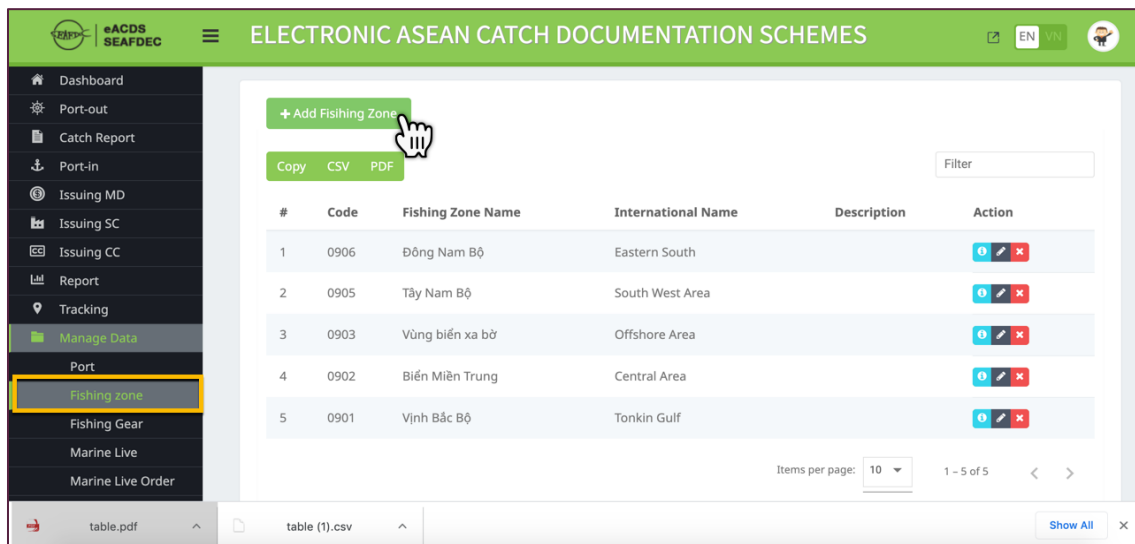


Figure 2-7: Fishing Zone Database under the “Manage Data” Menu

- ✓ From “Manage Data” menu, click on “Fishing Zone” sub-menu, the main window will appear as **Figure 2-7**.
- ✓ To add a new fishing zone by clicking “Add Fishing Zone” icon, a new template for input a fishing zone such as fishing zone code, name and international name, and description, will appear as **Figure 2-8**.
- ✓ After all information input, click “save”, the system will record all new fishing zone information under a fishing zone name.

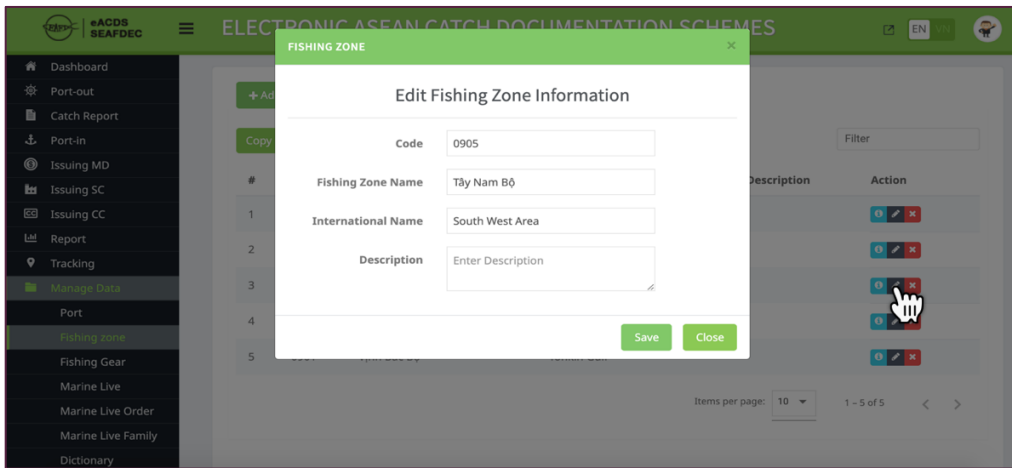


Figure 2-9: Editing Page for Fishing Zone Information

- ✓ Admin can view all recorded fishing zone information by click “information” icon of each fishing zone, a new window will appear. In addition, admin also can edit the fishing zone information by click “Edit” icon as shown in **Figure 2-9**.

CHAPTER 2-3: FISHING GEAR

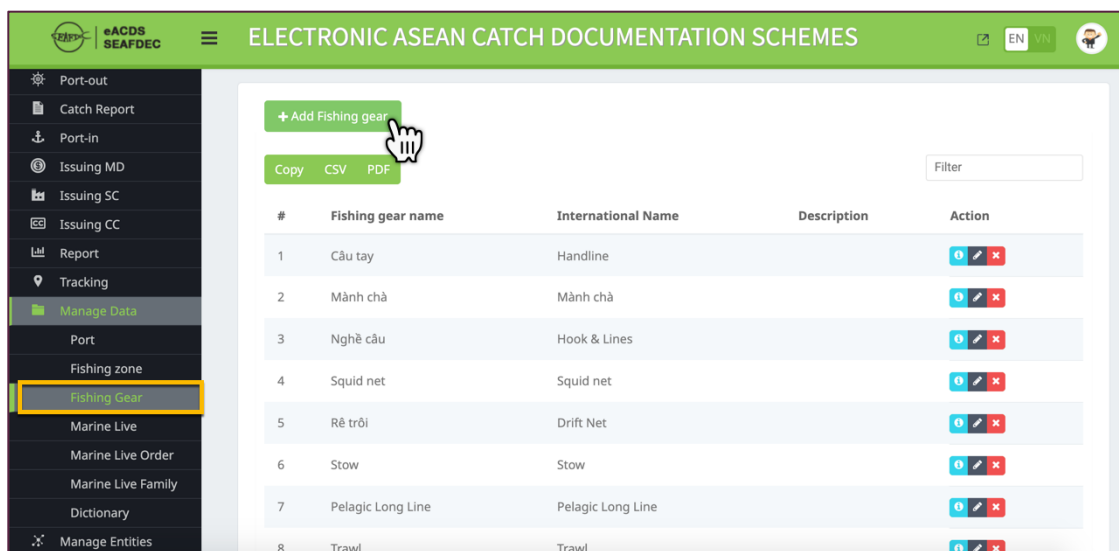


Figure 2-10: Fishing Gear Database under the “Manage Data” Menu

- ✓ From “Manage Data” menu, click on “Fishing Gear” sub-menu, the main window will appear as **Figure 2-10**.
- ✓ To add a new fishing gear by clicking “Add Fishing Gear” icon, a new template for input a fishing gear information such as name and international name, and description, will appear as **Figure 2-11**.
- ✓ After all information input, click “save”, the system will record all new fishing gear information under a fishing gear name.
- ✓ Admin can view all recorded fishing gear information by click “information” icon of each fishing gear. In addition, admin also can edit the fishing gear information by click “Edit” icon, a new window will appear as shown in **Figure 2-12**.
- ✓ From **Figure 2-10**, admin can download a list of fishing gears by click ‘PDF’ icon, the system will create a PDF format file and save it in the admin’s computer as **Annex 1**.

CHAPTER 2-4: MARINE LIVE

- ✓ The database for marine live including marine fishes (*e.g.* cartilaginous fish and bony fish) cephalopods (*e.g.* squid, octopus, cuttlefish), crustaceans (*e.g.* crabs, prawns, and shrimp). The system separates marine live information into three (3) levels including 1) all marine live information, 2) order level, and 3) family level.
- ✓ From “Manage Data” menu, click on “Marine Live” sub-menu, the main window will appear as **Figure 2-13** in which the information of each marine live relates to species.
- ✓ To add a new marine live species related to marine capture at sea by clicking “Add Marine Live” icon, a new template for input a fish species information such as Taxo Code, 3 Alphabet Code (3ACode), local name, common name (international name), scientific name, Order name, Family name, fishing gear, description, and uploading fish species image, will appear as **Figure 2-14**.
- ✓ After all information input, click “save”, the system will record fish species information in the system.
- ✓ Admin can view all recorded species information by click “information” icon of each marine live information. In addition, admin also can edit each marine live information by click “Edit” icon.

- ✓ From **Figure 2-13**, admin can download a list of marine live species by click ‘PDF’ icon, the system will create a PDF format file and save it in the admin’s computer as , a new window will appear as shown in **Figure 2-15**.

- ✓ To create or add “Order” of marine live from “Manage Data” menu, click on “Marine Live Order” sub-menu, the new window, shows each order name relates to species will appear as **Figure 2-16**.

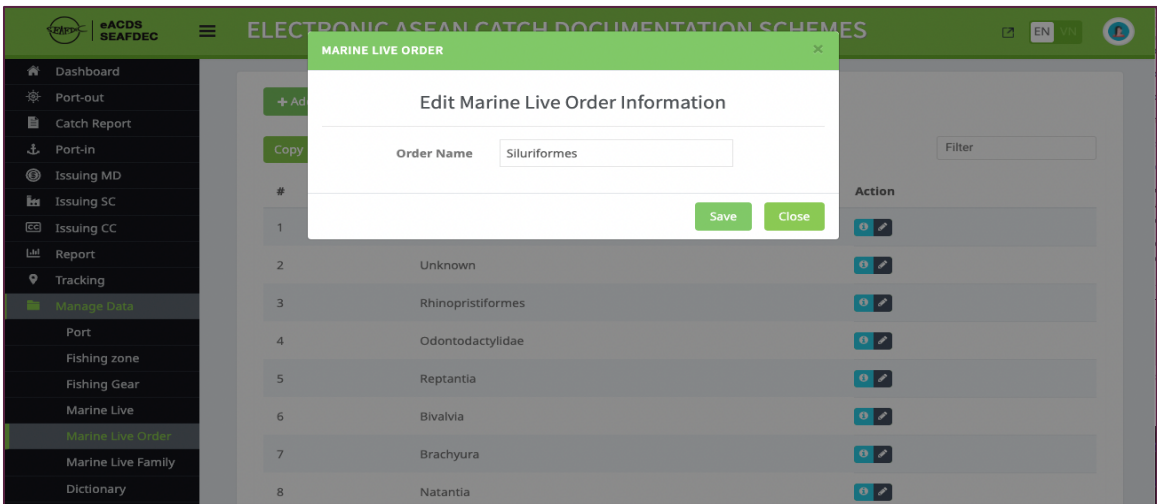


Figure 2-17: Template for Editing the Order Information

- ✓ Admin can view each order by click “information” icon. In addition, Admin also can edit each marine live information by click “Edit” icon, a new window will appear as shown in **Figure 2-17**.

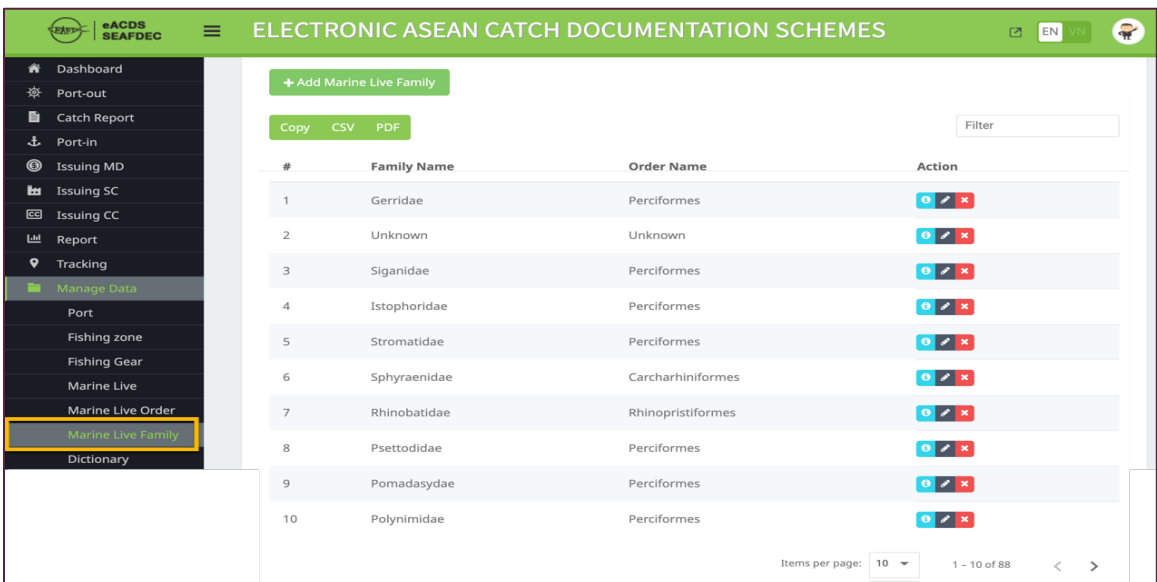


Figure 2-18: Family page of the marine live

- ✓ The same practices for create or add “Family” of marine live from “Manage Data” menu, click on “Marine Live Family” sub-menu, the new window, shows each family name related to order will appear as **Figure 2-18**.

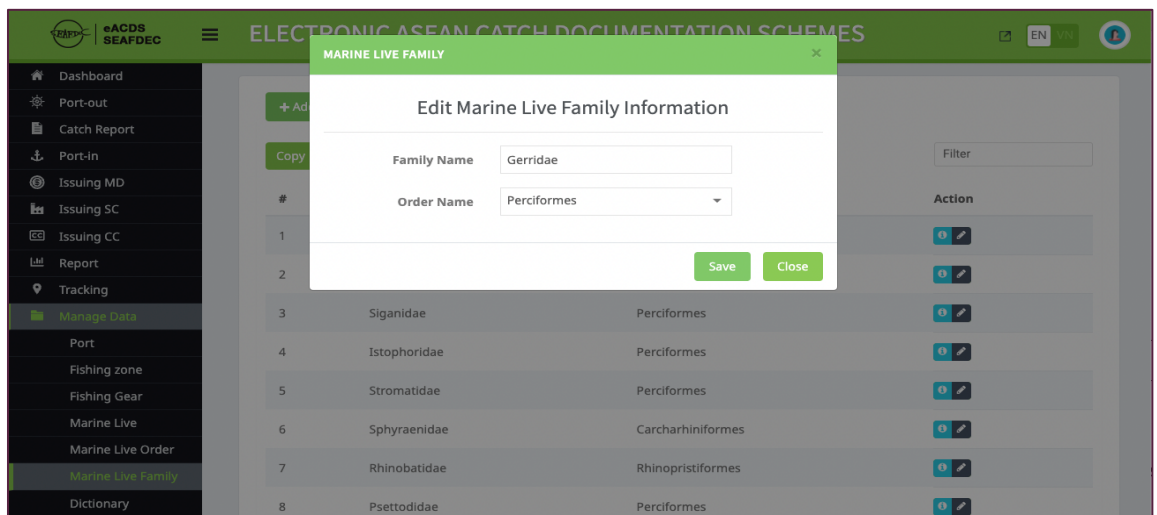


Figure 2-19: Template for Editing the Family Information Related to the Order

- ✓ Admin can view each Family by click “information” icon. In addition, admin also can edit each marine live information by click “Edit” icon, a new window will appear as shown in **Figure 2-19**.

CHAPTER 2-5: DICTIONARY

- ✓ The eACDS web-based application and mobile application are originally created in English language, however SEAFDEC Training Department eACDS team have worked with country to translate English words to local language. About 1,030 words and texts used in both applications are translated into local languages.

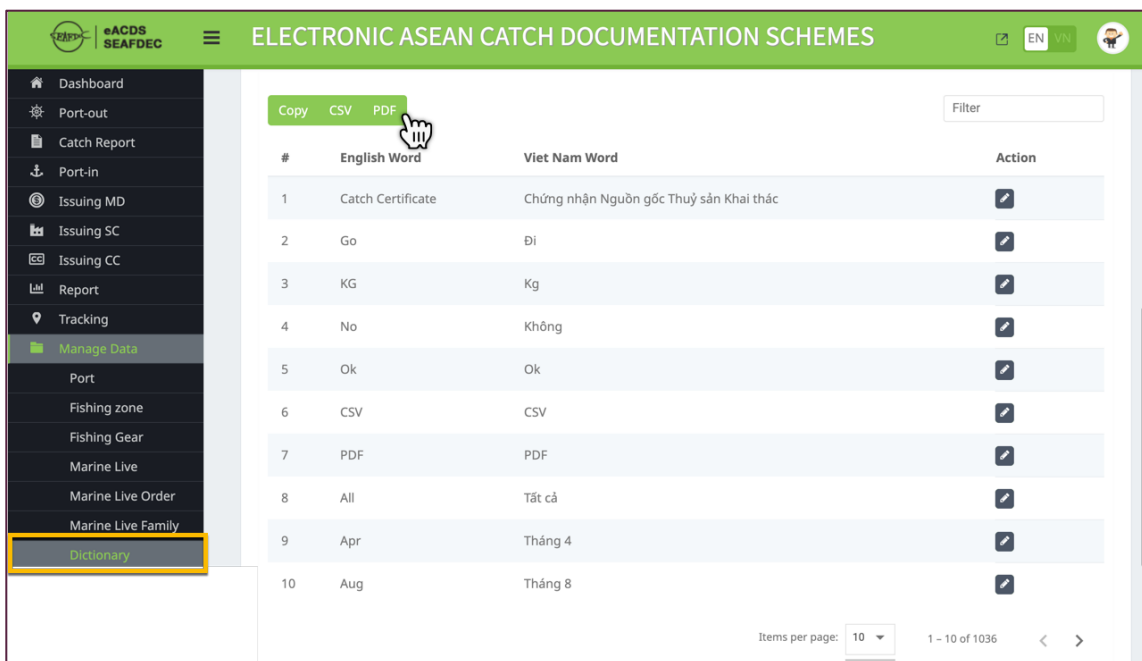


Figure 2-20: Dictionary Page

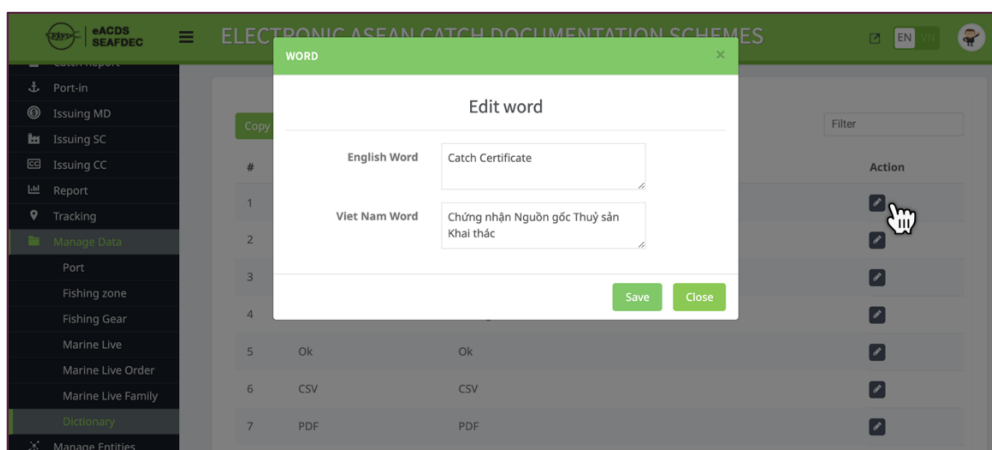



Figure 2-21: Template for Editing to Translate from Original English to Local Language

- ✓ To edit the translated words and texts, admin officer can do it directly by clicking “Dictionary” sub-menu under the “Manage Data” menu, then a new window will appear as **Figure 2-20**. Then click on “edit” icon of each word or text for editing as shown in **Figure 2-21**.
- ✓ To view all original and translated words and texts by click “PDF” icon, the system will download a dictionary table in a PDF file format in the user computer (see detailed sample as **Annex 3**).

CHAPTER 3: ENTITY MANAGEMENT

- ✓ This chapter focuses on the entity management consisting of three (3) entities: users, vessels, and company database.
- ✓ On the main menus of the eACDS database for administrator, select “Manage Entities” menu following by the sub-menu, the admin can create or manage the entities.
- ✓ The “User” sub-menu is for admin to create a new user who is authorized to access to the eACDS system. A term of “User” means any person who is concerned in the supply chains of the catch documentation scheme such as fisher, vessel owner, fish buyer, fish processor, *etc.*
- ✓ “Vessel” sub-menu is for admin to create or manage a record of fishing vessel that is authorized for fishing operation under the national fisheries management policy. All vessels under the management policy must register to the eACDS system. The vessel data will also be linked to the “User” record.
- ✓ “Company” sub-menu is for admin to create or manage a record of all company concerned in the eACDS system such as fish buyer company, fish processor company, *etc.* The company information will be linked to the “User” record.
- ✓ Administrator, herein after called “Admin” can manage a role of user based on the functions that allow user to access. For example, fishing master (user) will be limited to access to the system for specific functions: request for port out, catch reporting at sea, request for port in, and sale fish at landing site, *etc.*

CHAPTER 3-1: CREATE/MANAGE “USER” ENTITY

- ✓ Select a “Manage Entities” menu and click “User” sub-menu, the list of users consists of specific information such as name, e-mail address, company name, role of user, and role group related to their authority will show on the right-side window as **Figure 3-1**.

- ✓ To create a new user entity, click on “Add User” icon as shown in **Figure 3-1**, then a new window will appear as **Figure 3-2**.

- ✓ A user entity includes the following information:
 - **I.C. No.** is a identity card number,
 - **Full name** is in according with the I.C No.
 - **E-mail address**, for communication and access to the system
 - **Password** and **confirmed password**: admin can create a user password for accessing the system,
 - **Profile image**: This image is provided by the user during registration process. The admin can upload a profile image to the system,
 - **Signature**: The scanned signature image is provided by the user during a registration process. Admin can upload a scanned image to the system,
 - **Company name**: This part links to the other data set under the “Company” submenu. The pop-up list of company name will appear after moving the curser on this item or field.
 - **User role**: There are three (3) main categories for choosing by admin, namely
 - 1) Vessel owner* and fishing master: they require to access the system for port out, port in and catch reporting.

- 2) Officer: In this traceability system, many relevant governmental agencies are involved in the eACDS system such as fishing port authority, fishery management authorities covering fishing activity, monitoring, fish processing plants, food safety authority, *etc.*
 - 3) User^{**}: all users concern in the traceability system are included such as fish buyer and seller, fish processing plants, *etc.*
- **Role group:** This menu allows Admin to create a group name or later grouping the user by group name. In principle, there are many users register to the system, some user role can be grouped by admin such as port officer group, local admin group, vessel owner group, processor group, *etc.*
 - **Authorities:** This menu allow admin to specify the authorized access to each user. Keep in mind that all users cannot equality access to the system functions. Especially the most important parts of data and entity management which are for admin or local admin only. In addition, some functions are also for specific user such as catch reporting at sea is for fishing master accessing only, Catch Certification (CC) page is for fish processor only. However, Admin can select more than one function for specific user, and when user access to the eACDS system, the main menu of website will be appeared alignment with the provided functions. For example, fishing master and vessel owner cannot see other menus such as Statement of Catch (SC) page, Catch Certification (CC) page and management pages. There are eleven (11) functions based on the traceability processes, summary/reporting, and system management, such as
 - a) Port out page,
 - b) catch report page,
 - c) port in page,
 - d) MD page,
 - e) SC page,
 - f) CC page,
 - g) Report,
 - h) Tracking data,
 - i) Manage data,
 - j) Manage entity, and
 - k) Dashboard page

Remarks:

(*) If Admin identifies user as a “Vessel Owner”, four (4) additional information (see **Figure 3-2-1**) are required for inputs namely:

- Reg No.: Registration number of fishing vessel)
- Address: Contact address
- Telephone: Contact telephone number
- Facsimile: contact facsimile number

(**) If Admin identifies user as a “User”, three additional information (see **Figure 3-2-2**) are required for inputs namely:

- Address: Contact address
- Telephone: Contact telephone number
- Facsimile: contact facsimile number

- ✓ To edit the user entity, admin can edit the information by clicking “edit” icon as shown in Figure 3-1, a data record will appear as **Figure 3-3**.

CHAPTER 3-2: CREATE/MANAGE VESSEL ENTITY

- ✓ Select a “Manage Entities” menu and click “Vessel” sub-menu, the system will show on the right-side window as **Figure 3-4**.
- ✓ The “Vessel” page consists of two (2) components: 1) fishing vessel, and 2) transshipment vessel.

A. FISHING VESSEL INFORMATION

- ✓ Select “fishing vessel” tap, a window will show key information such as vessel name, owner name, fishing gear, fishing zone, fishing expiry date, gear expiry date, and action as shown in **Figure 3-4**.

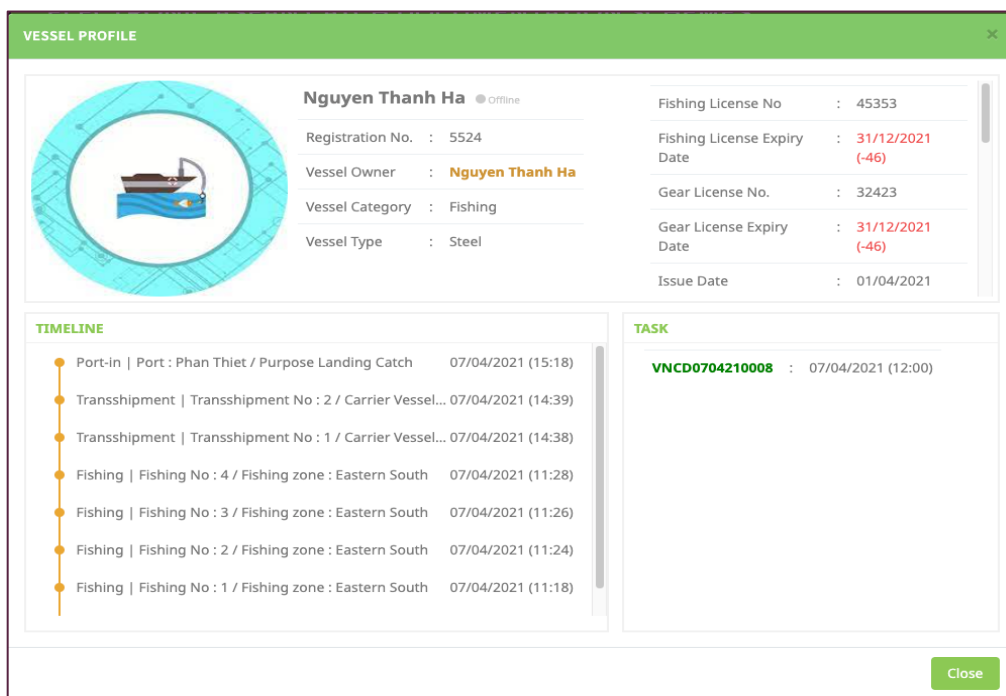


Figure 3-7: A sample of fishing profile

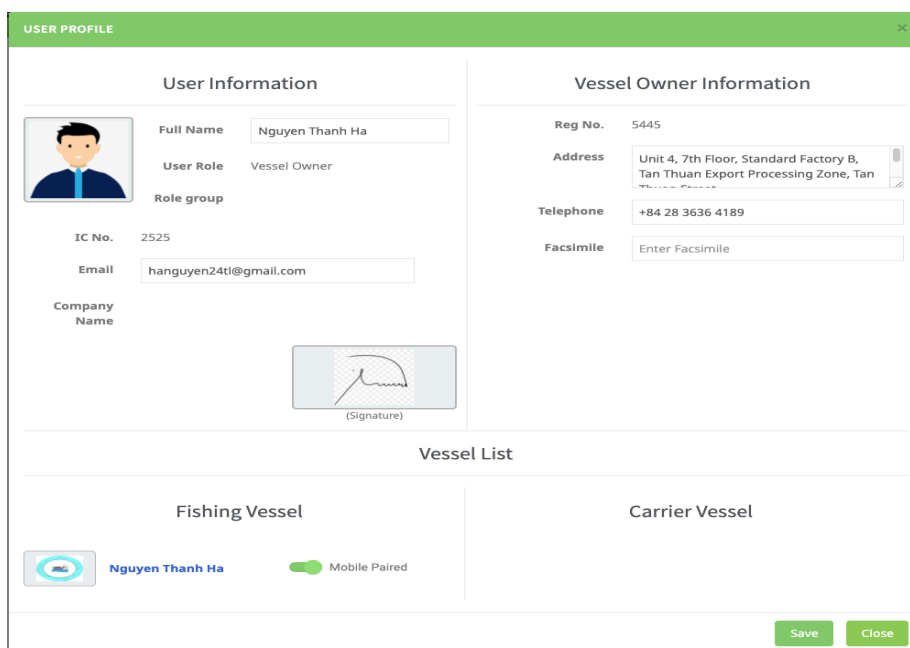


Figure 3-8: A Profile of Vessel Owner

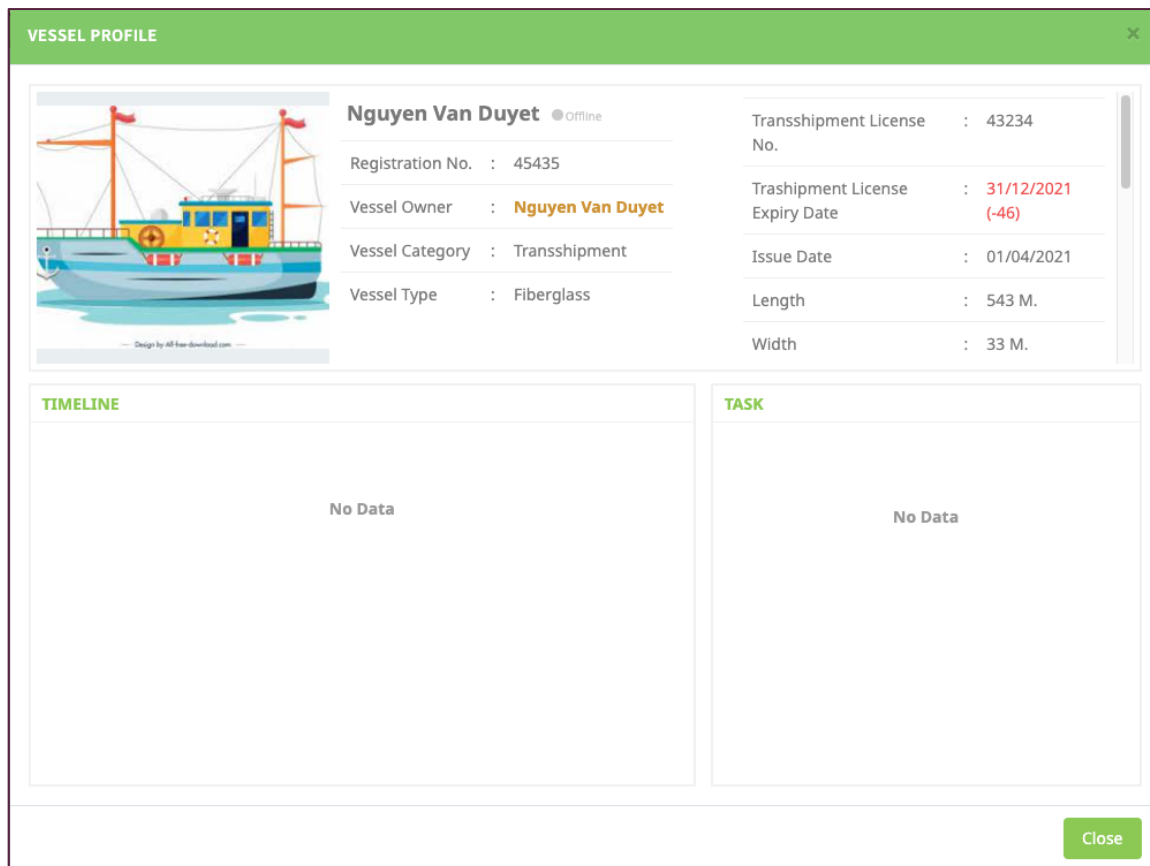


Figure 3-11: Transshipment Vessel Profile

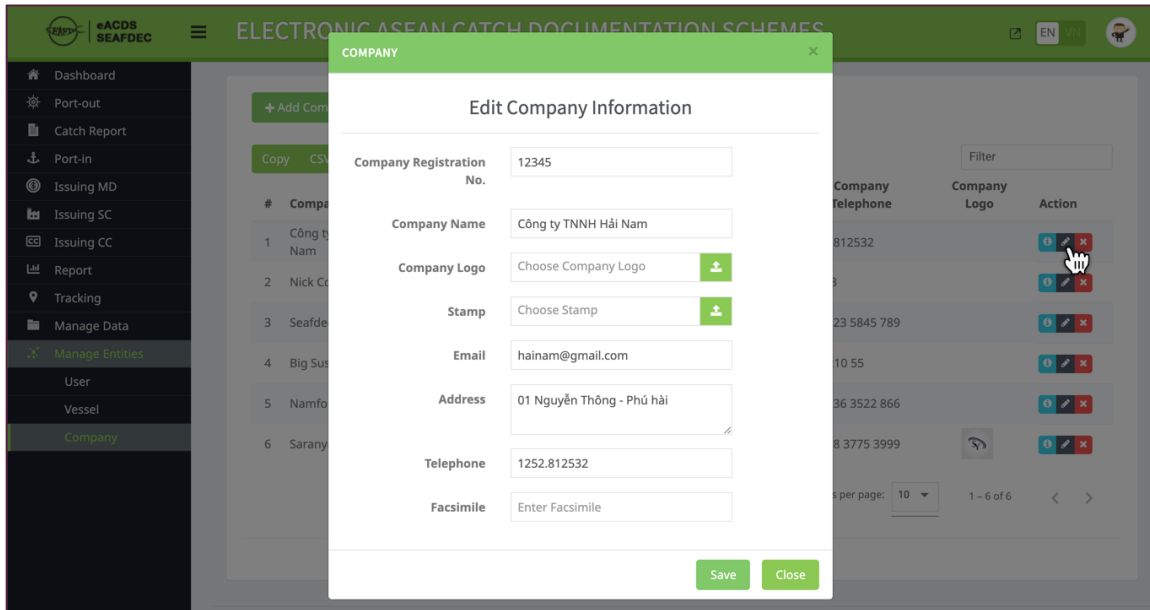


Figure 3-14: Edit Company Information Page
