REPORT OF THE MEETING

1. Consultation meeting for arrangement of site-based Fisheries Refugia management board in Surat Thani Province for the project entitled "Establishment and Operation of a Regional System of Fisheries Refugia in the South China Sea and Gulf of Thailand" was conducted at Surat Thani Fisheries Provincial Office on 29th January 2019. It was aimed to make a clarification of the Project purposes and activities, and consultation on the membership properties of Site-Based Fisheries Refugia Management Board in Surat Thani Province.




Figure 1 Study area for Fisheries Refugia site in Surat Thani Province

- 2. **Ms. Praulai Nootmorn**, National Focal Point for Thailand, explained the meeting about the purposes and activities of Fisheries Refugia project. She also mentioned that blue swimming crab was agreed by Thailand's National Fisheries Refugia Committee and Thailand's National Scientific and Technical Committee to be the priority species in Surat Thani Province with its study area for Fisheries Refugia site shown in figure 1.
- 3. **Mr. Kowit Kao- ian**, Director of Surat Thani Fisheries Provincial Office, and his team acknowledged the purposes, activities, and study area for Fisheries Refugia site in Surat Thani Province. He also advised the meeting that Koh Sed in Ban Don Bay was one of the suitable areas for Fisheries Refugia site due to its rich ecosystem, especially the existence of seagrass bed.

- **5.** The meeting discussed Terms of Reference (TORs) for Site-Based Fisheries Refugia Management Board in Surat Thani Province. The TORs were subsequently set up as follows:
 - Recommend for execution of establishment and operation of Fisheries Refugia in Surat Thani Province;
 - Review and approve work plan and outputs of Fisheries Refugia project regarding its purposes and goal;
 - Facilitate co-operation with relevant provincial organizations to promote the integrated approaches for effective management of fisheries resources and Fisheries Refugia under related concepts and regulations;
 - Review and approve progress reports for transmission to the meetings of the National Fisheries Refugia Committee;
 - Facilitate laying down the measures for sustainable management of Fisheries Refugia in Surat Thani Province under acceptances from stakeholders and relevant provincial organizations; and
 - Take the other necessary actions for effectiveness of Fisheries Refugia management in Surat Thani Province.
- 6. **Mr. Kowit Kao-ian**, Director of Surat Thani Fisheries Provincial Office, and his staff would proceed to prepare the Notification of Surat Thani Province on appointment of Site-Based

Fisheries Refugia Management Board in Surat Thani Province, consisted of members and TORs as discussed and agreed.

7. **Ms. Praulai Nootmorn,** National Focal Point for Thailand, **Mr. Jirawut Kumpirod**, Fishery Technical Officer, and **Ms. Ratana Munprasit**, Fisheries Refugia Project Staff, visited Koh Sed in Ban Don Bay to observe its ecosystem
