REPORT OF THE MEETING

The third meeting of Site-based Fisheries *Refugia* Management Board in Surat Thani Province for the Project entitled "Establishment and Operation of a Regional System of Fisheries *Refugia* in the South China Sea and Gulf of Thailand" was organized by Chumphon Fisheries Research and Development Center, Department of Fisheries on 14th December 2021, 09.00 – 17.00 hours, at Wang Tai Hotel, Surat Thani Province. The meeting was presided over by Mr. Itthiphon Kwathai, Director of Surat Thani Fisheries Provincial Office acting as chairman of the committee. There were totally 40 participants joined the meeting, including board committee, resource persons, project officers, and observers from Department of Fisheries and private sectors. Meeting agenda and list of participants are shown in Annex 1 and 2, respectively. The meeting minutes are as follows:

AGENDA 1 REPORT OF THE CHAIRMAN

1.1 Mr. Itthiphon Kwathai, the chairman, welcomed all participants and expressed his pleasure that Surat Thani Province was one of the fisheries *refugia* sites in the Gulf of Thailand. He mentioned that as the coastal zone of Surat Thani was significant for fishing ground and nursery ground of fisheries resources in the Gulf of Thailand, fisheries *refugia* project in the province could enhance technical-based development of fisheries management under the recognition, cooperation, and consensus of fishers, officers, and all stakeholders in the area. He expressed his hope that this meeting would be the mechanism to promote sustainability of fisheries resources and fishers' living along with the prominence as tourist spot of the area. He also wished fisheries *refugia* in Surat Thani be a best practice for coastal fisheries management in Thailand and in the South China Sea on the whole.

AGENDA 2 APPROVAL OF REPORT OF THE PREVIOUS MEETING

- **2.1 Mr. Jirawut Kumpiroch**, Committee and Assistant Secretary, informed the meeting that report of the previous meeting, that is, the Second Meeting of Site-Based Fisheries *Refugia* Management Board in Surat Thani Province on 28th December 2020, had been handed out to each committee member for consideration. In this regard, he requested the committee to consider, amend, and approve the report that was prepared as the attachment to the meeting document.
- **2.2 Meeting Resolution:** The meeting approved report of the Second Meeting of Site-Based Fisheries *Refugia* Management Board in Surat Thani Province on 28th December 2020.

AGENDA 3 MATTERS OF REPORT

3.1 Progress of Project Implementation

- 3.1.1 **Ms. Praulai Nootmorn**, Senior Expert in Marine Fisheries and National Focal Point for Thailand, reported to the meeting the progress of project implementation in the year 2021, by activities and their results. Her presentation is shown in Annex 3 and concluded as follows:
- 1) Conducting the Second Meeting of Site-Based Fisheries *Refugia* Management Board in Surat Thani Province on 28th December 2020

Meeting resolution:

- Two options of fisheries *refugia* area were to be proposed for consideration in the local stakeholder consultations:
 - the rectangular area of 2x3 km² (3,750 Thai rai) around Koh Sed, and
 - the area of over 2x3 km² around Koh Sed, extended to some extent;
- Measures according to Section 56 and 71 (1) in the Royal Ordinance on Fisheries B.E. 2558 (2015) were to be taken into consideration for management planning of fisheries *refugia* in Koh Sed; and

- Local stakeholder consultations were to be conducted at all the coastal communities in Ban Don Bay of Surat Thani Province in order to provide community-based boundary delineation and management planning of fisheries *refugia* for blue swimming crab in Koh Sed.
- 2) Conducting 7 local stakeholder consultation workshops on fisheries *refugia* boundary and management planning in Surat Thai Site on $9^{th} 15^{th}$ March 2021

Meeting resolution:

- Fisheries *refugia* boundary:

An area of approximately $1.5x6 = 9 \text{ km}^2$ (5,625 Thai rai) with rectangular boundary lying longitudinally northeast-southwest along the water channel, covering all sand dune area of Koh Sed (Figure 1); and

- Management planning:
 - Management measure:

Section 71 (1) in the Royal Ordinance on Fisheries B.E. 2558 (2015) – The Minister or the provincial fisheries committee shall have the power to issue notifications regarding the following: (1) fishing gears according to their forms, fishing methods, fishing areas, the size of fishing vessels used in fishing operation and other conditions that are prohibited from fishing operations in fishing grounds;

- Prohibited fishing gears:
 - (1) Crab trap,
 - (2) Crab gill net, below 3.0 inch in mesh-size, and
 - (3) All types of clam fishing operated in motor vessels.
- 3) Conducting cooperating survey with community to define geographic location of tentative fisheries *refugia* boundary around Koh Sed of Surat Thani Site on 30th March 2021




Figure 2 Geographic location of tentative fisheries *refugia* boundary around Koh Sed of Surat Thani Site based on stakeholder consultation:

Survey results: geographic location of tentative fisheries *refugia* boundary around Koh Sed of Surat Thani Site was defined as shown in figure 2.

- 4) Conducting the eighth meeting of Thailand's National Fisheries *Refugia* Committee on 19th April 2021

Meeting resolution:

- Memberships of Thailand's National Fisheries *Refugia* Committee, Thailand's National Scientific and Technical Committee, Site-Based Fisheries *Refugia* Management Board in Trat Province, and Site-Based Fisheries *Refugia* Management Board in Surat Thani Province were to be revised in accordance with the reorganization in the institutions related to the membership of each committee;
- Geographic location of fisheries *refugia* site at Koh Sed, Surat Thani Province was to be prepared and verified by Chumphon Marine Fisheries Research and Development Center;
- Notification on the fisheries *refugia* at Surat Thani Site was to be drafted by Surat Thani Fisheries Provincial Office and verified by Legal Division of the Department of Fisheries prior to submission to Surat Thani Provincial Fisheries Committee for consideration and approved; and
- Technical Data for short mackerel resources from gill net fisheries during the year 2018-2021 were to be prepared by Rayong Marine Fisheries Research and Development Center and submitted to Thailand's National Scientific and Technical Committee for consideration and determination of the management planning for fisheries *refugia* of short mackerel at Trat Site.
- 4) Creating online national web portal for fisheries *refugia* in Thailand
 Results: online national web portal for fisheries *refugia* in Thailand was created with a URL of https://inter.fisheries.go.th/fishrefugia. Initial menu of the web portal are as follows:

- 5) Conducting the fifth meeting of Thailand's National Scientific and Technical Committee on 6^{th} July 2021

Meeting resolution:

- Geographical location of the boundary of fisheries *refugia* in Koh Sed of Surat Thani Site was approved by Thailand's National Scientific and Technical Committee; and
- Additional technical information on catch composition of short mackerel from trawlers, purse seiners, and gill netters were to be prepared by Rayong Marine Fisheries Research and Development Center and proposed to Thailand's National Scientific and Technical Committee for consideration of the appropriate management plan in Trat fisheries *refugia* area.
- 6) Conducting the sixth meeting of Thailand's National Scientific and Technical Committee on 11th August 2021

Meeting resolution:

- Prohibition of 2 fishing vessels, purse seiners and trawlers, fishing in Trat fisheries *refugia* site at the period of January February should be the measures for short mackerel resources management in Trat site;
- For additional supporting data, fishing efforts of each principal fishing vessel for short mackerel in Trat Province at the period of January February in the year 2020-2021 were to be prepared by Rayong Marine Fisheries Research and Development Center; and
- Fisheries *refugia* for short mackerel in Trat Site together with its management measures and supporting data were to be submitted to Aquatic Resources Conservation Committee of the Department of Fisheries for consideration and approval.
- 7) Proposing the Notification of Surat Thani Provincial Fisheries Committee Re: Prescribing Fishing Gears Prohibited from Fishing in Coastal Seas around Koh Sed, Phum Riang Subdistrict, Chaiya District, Surat Thani Province B.E. 2564 (2021) for consideration by the Aquatic Resources Conservation Committee of the Department of Fisheries on 28th September 2121

Meeting resolution: the Notification was approved in principle by the Committee with recommendation that the rational and the prohibited fishing gear described in the Notification were to be amended before proposing to the Minister of Agriculture and Cooperative for the final approval.

- 3.1.2 **Meeting Resolution:** The meeting acknowledged.
- 3.2 Notification of Surat Thani Provincial Fisheries Committee Re: Prescribing Fishing Gears
 Prohibited from Fishing in Coastal Seas around Koh Sed, Phum Riang Subdistrict, Chaiya
 District, Surat Thani Province B.E. 2564 (2021)
- 3.2.1 **Mr. Itthiphon Kwathai**, Director of Surat Thani Fisheries Provincial Office and chairman of the committee, reported to the meeting on the chronological preparation of the Notification of Surat Thani Provincial Fisheries Committee Re: Prescribing Fishing Gears Prohibited from Fishing in Coastal Seas around Koh Sed, Phum Riang Subdistrict, Chaiya District, Surat Thani Province as follows:

- Geographical boundary of fisheries *refugia* at Koh Sed of Surat Thani Site and its management plan agreed by the stakeholder consultation meetings were approved by Surat Thani Provincial Fisheries Committee;
- Notification of Surat Thani Provincial Fisheries Committee Re: Prescribing Fishing Gears Prohibited from Fishing in Coastal Seas around Koh Sed, Phum Riang Subdistrict, Chaiya District, Surat Thani Province B.E. 2564 (2021) was prepared;
- The Notification was approved in principle by the Aquatic Resources Conservation Committee of the Department of Fisheries with recommendation that the rational and the prohibited fishing gear described in the Notification were to be amended before proposing to the Minister of Agriculture and Cooperative for final approval; and
- The Notification was amended and prepared for approval by the Minister of Agriculture and Cooperative.
- 3.2.2 **Mr. Somporn Kuasakul**, Fisheries Administration and Management Group Head, Surat Thani Fisheries Provincial Office, additionally presented to the meeting the concise knowledge of fisheries laws, regulations, and measures for fisheries management in Thailand.
- 3.2.3 **Meeting Resolution:** the meeting acknowledged.
- 3.3 Case Study: Community-based Management in Coastal Fishing Area of Ban Pak Don Sak, Don Sak Subdistrict, Don Sak District, Surat Thani Province




Figure 3 Notification of Surat Thani Provincial Fisheries Committee Re: Prescribing Fishing Gears, Fishing Methods, and Fishing Areas Prohibited from fishing in Some Fishing Areas B.E. 2562 (2019)

- 3.3.1 **Mr. Suphalak Tieobut**, Chairman of the Community-based Fisheries Management Activities Committee in Ban Pak Don Sak, presented to the meeting that Ban Pak Don Sak community had executed the activity of community-based fisheries management by establishing the conservation and rehabilitation area of 1,010 Thai rai (1.6 km²) for blue swimming resources in the coastal zone of the community. He noted that the conservation area was formally notified on 4th December 2019 by the Notification of Surat Thani Provincial Fisheries Committee Re: Prescribing Fishing Gears, Fishing Methods, and Fishing Areas Prohibited from fishing in Some Fishing Areas B.E. 2562 (2019) (Figure 3).

- **Mr. Suphalak** mentioned that operational management board was established for monitoring and surveillance in the area as well as for cooperation of community-based management planning with the relevant agencies. He also noted that blue swimming crabs in the area apparently increased after the conservation activities and the effectiveness of the Notification.
- 3.3.2 **Mr. Jirot Puakkliang**, Chairman of the Local Fishing Community Organization of Tha Chang District Coastal Small-scale Fishing Group, made recommendations on how to accomplish the fisheries management in the area which was composed of 3 components, i.e., budget, personnel, and TOR for implementation. He noted that management plan should be prepared for short term, middle term, and long term implementations concerning socio-economic of fishers in the area.
- 3.3.3 **Meeting Resolution:** the meeting acknowledged.

AGENDA 4 MATTERS FOR CONSIDERATION

- 4.1 Nomination of the members of Fisheries *Refugia* Operational Management Board in Surat Thani Site
- 4.1.1 **Mr. Itthiphon Kwathai**, the chairman, invited the meeting to raise the names or positions appropriate to be the members of Fisheries *Refugia* Operational Management Board in Koh Sed of Surat Thani Site.
- 4.1.2 **Mr. Prasert Chanjukorn**, Li Let Subdistrict Head, recommended that members of the Board should be the officers from the Department of Provincial Administration and the Department of Local Administration, as well as the members of local fishing community organizations, small-scale fishing groups, and small-scale fishers in Surat Thani Province.
- 4.1.3 **Mr. Charin Choeichoe**, Chairman of the Local Fishing Community Organization of Phum Riang Subdistrict Aquatic Resources Conservation Group, noted that the area of Koh Sed had been utilized by fishers of many districts around Ban Don Bay, thus members of the Operational Management Board should be stakeholders from all the districts involved which would be resulted in the cooperation of management and problem solving.
- 4.1.4 Discussion was done and the nominated members of Fisheries *Refugia* Operational Management Board in Surat Thani Site were concluded as follows:
 - 1) Mayor of Phum Riang Subdistrict (as a chairman),
 - Li Let Subdistrict Head (as a vice-chairman),
- 3) Chairman of the Local Fishing Community Organization of Phum Riang Subdistrict Aquatic Resources Conservation Group (as a secretary),
 - 4) Mayors of the coastal subdistricts in Chaiya District,
 - 5) Subdistrict Heads of the coastal subdistricts in Chaiya District,
 - 6) Chairmen of the Local Fishing Community Organizations in Chaiya District,
 - 7) Representatives of the 6 districts other than Chaiya District around Ban Don Bay,
 - 8) Chairman of Forest and Sea for Life Foundation,
 - 9) Fisheries District Office Chiefs of the districts around Ban Don Bay,
 - 10) Lang Suan Marine Fisheries Patrol Unit (Chumphon) Head, Department of Fisheries, and
- 11) Fisheries Administration and Management Group Head, Surat Thani Fisheries Provincial Office, Department of Fisheries.
- 4.1.5 **Meeting Resolution:** the meeting agreed on the above conclusion.
- 4.2 Terms of Reference for Fisheries Refugia Operational Management Board in Surat Thani Site
- 4.2.1 **Mr. Somporn Kuasakul**, Fisheries Administration and Management Group Head, Surat Thani Fisheries Provincial Office, acting as a committee and secretary, presented to the meeting the tentative terms of reference (TOR) for Fisheries *Refugia* Operational Management Board in Surat Thani Site as follows:

- 1) Provide the communities with management plan based on the Notification of Surat Thani Provincial Fisheries Committee Re: Prescribing Fishing Gears Prohibited from Fishing in Coastal Seas around Koh Sed, Phum Riang Subdistrict, Chaiya District, Surat Thani Province;
- 2) Cooperate with relevant agencies in planning and implementing activities and projects for fisheries management in Surat Thani fisheries *refugia* site (Koh Sed);
- 3) Review and evaluate progress in implementation of the activities and projects, and provide guidance for improvement to the communities
- 4) Monitor the fishing activities in Surat Thani fisheries *refugia* site in accordance with the Notification; and
- 5) Conduct any other activities that contribute to the effectiveness of the fisheries management for sustainability of fisheries resources and ecosystem in Surat Thani fisheries refugia site.
- 4.2.2 **Mr. Itthiphon Kwathai**, the chairman, invited the committee members to consider the presented tentative TOR and raise any comments for their adjustment.
- 4.2.3 **Dr. Praween Chulphakdi**, Chairman of Forest and Sea for Life Foundation, commented that such Operational Management Board should have authority for law enforcement, and the Board should connect and cooperate with the academic bodies carrying out research works in the area.
- 4.2.4 **Mr. Itthiphon Kwathai**, the chairman, noted the comments and presented to the meeting that members of the Board could have authority for fishery law enforcement by being trained in the course of "enhancing efficiency for fisheries officer assistant" organized by the Department of Fisheries.
- 4.2.5 **Mr. Jirot Puakkliang**, Chairman of the Local Fishing Community Organization of Tha Chang District Coastal Small-scale Fishing Group, added the comments that enhancing community uptake of knowledge and awareness was also essential for fisheries management in fisheries *refugia* site.
- 4.2.6 **Meeting Resolution:** the meeting agreed on the presented tentative TOR.

AGENDA 5 ANY OTHER BUSINESS

5.1 Installation of Buoys for Fisheries *Refugia* Boundary Marking at Surat Thani Site

5.1.1 **Ms. Jinda Petchkamnerd**, Director of Chumphon Marine Fisheries Research and Development Center, presented to the meeting that there would be an activity of buoy installation for boundary marking around Koh Sed of Surat Thani fisheries *refugia* site. In this regard, she proposed the pattern of installation having the interval of 500 meters and composed of 32 orange round-buoys, shown in Figure 4, to the meeting for consideration, recommendation, and comments.

- 5.1.2 **Mr. Charin Choeichoeichom**, Chairman of the Local Fishing Community Organization of Phum Riang Subdistrict Aquatic Resources Conservation Group, recommended pole installing for more permanent boundary markers. In case of buoys, he recommended 200 meters interval for making the fisheries *refugia* boundary more noticeable.
- 5.1.3 **Mr. Somporn Kuasakul**, Fisheries Administration and Management Group Head, Surat Thani Fisheries Provincial Office, clarified that pole installing must be done under the permission of Marine Department, making the activity more complicate.
- 5.1.4 **Ms. Jinda Petchkamnerd** noted the recommended 200 meters interval of buoy installation. She informed the meeting that the number of buoys installed would be up to the budget provided.
- 5.1.5 **Dr. Praween Chulphakdi**, Chairman of Forest and Sea for Life Foundation, recommended enhancing the community recognition that Koh Sed was a fisheries *refugia* for blue swimming crab in Ban Don Bay of Surat Thani Province.
- 5.1.6 **Mr. Jirot Puakkliang**, Chairman of the Local Fishing Community Organization of Tha Chang District Coastal Small-scale Fishing Group, recommended cooperating of small-scale fishers in buoy installation.
- 5.1.7 **Meeting Resolution:** the meeting agreed that orange round-buoys were to be used for fisheries *refugia* boundary marking around Koh Sed of Surat Thani Site with the interval of 500 meters, whereas 200 meters interval was optional.





- ห้ามทำการประมงในระหว่างเดือนมกราคมถึงกุมภาพันธ์ เนื่องจากเป็น ช่วงเวลาที่พบปลาทูไข่แก่มาก
- ให้อวนลอยปลาทูสามารถทำการประมงในพื้นที่หลบภัยได้ เนื่องจากเป็น เรือประมงพื้นบ้านซึ่งมีจำนวนไม่มากนัก มีองค์ประกอบของปลาทูน้อยในผลจับ และ มีสัดส่วนการจับปลาทูในปริมาณน้อยเมื่อเทียบกับปริมาณการจับจากเครื่องมืออวน ลากและอวนล้อมจับ


มติที่ประชม
