## **1. Opening Meeting**

**1.1.** The provincial stakeholder consultation meeting on finalizing management plan for mackerel refugia at Peam Krasob, Koh Kong province was organized by Fisheries Administration (FiA) of Cambodia collaborating with Koh Kong Provincial Administration and Koh Kong Fisheries Administration Cantonment on 9 December 2022, funded by SEAFDEC/UNEP/GEF Fisheries *Refugia* Project.

**1.2.** The meeting was conducted at Koh Kong Provincial Administration, which 30 participants was attended, and they from Provincial Administration, FiA, Department of Agriculture, Forestry, and Fisheries, Fisheries Administration Cantonment, Department of Land Management, Department of Environment, Department of Tourism, and District and Commune Authorities, Maritime Police, and Community Fisheries (see annex 1 and 3).

**1.3.** Mr. Ouk Vibol welcomed and expressed thanked very much to all participants taking their opportunities to join this meeting. He also informed that the management plan preparation for mackerel refugia was based on the MAFF's proclamation on establishment of management area of mackerel refugia at Peam Krasob, Koh Kong province dated on 16 September 2019. So far, this management plan reached finalizing and this meeting today is very important to get more inputs from all relevant stakeholders on the management plans.

**1.4.** Then, he proposed all participants to take part in active discussion and also declared to open this meeting from now.

## **2. Presentation on 5-year management plan for mackerel refugia at Peam Krasob, Koh Kong province**

**2.1.** Mr. Ouk Vibol presented the draft of 5-year management plan for mackerel refugia at Peam Krasob, Koh Kong province, focusing on the contents of the management plan, including Introduction, Fish Production, Involved Legislation Instruments, Action Plan, Structure of Action Implementation and Responsibility, Estimated Budget, Monitoring and Evaluation, Reference, and Appendix. Thus, he proposed all participants to consider and provide their inputs on the whole context.

**2.2.** He added that the preparation developing 5-year management plan was funded by SEAFDEC/UNEP/GEF Fisheries Refugia Project.

## **3. Discussion on Management Plan**

**3.1.** Mr. Ouk Vibol proposed all participant to discuss this draft management plan.

**3.2.** Mr. EE Meng Leang proposed consideration and the addition of the policy and strategy plan for fisheries sector management in Koh Kong province into introduction section.

**3.3.** Mr. Sok Chan Kresna had an idea that this is good idea and he supported this point that it is needed to include this point. Regarding tourism sector policy, provincial authority has participated in disseminating this policy to relevant stakeholders.

**3.4.** Mr. Prak Vicheth proposed to add an extension activity in Objective 1 that one activity is very important in law enforcement.

**3.5.** Mr. Hean Beurn proposed the meeting to consider water pollution from bordering countries and he proposed to include green mussel aquaculture in this management plan.

**3.6.** Mr. Chea Chan Khana proposed to do seaweed and green mussel culture helping to improve water quality.

**3.7.** Mr. Kao Monirith proposed meeting to consider spelling.

**3.8.** Mr. Ouk Vibol agreed to take all comments from the meeting and corrected this draft management plan.

**4.1.** Mr. Ouk Vibol expressed thanks very much for all participants who come to join today and provided a lot of inputs. Those inputs were very important for us to improve this management plan and he agreed to correct this draft document based on comments from the meeting.
