Electronic System of ACDS (eACDS)

The eACDS is a software including web and mobile applications to link all supply chains in one unique system implementing by all stakeholders such as fishing master, fish buyers, fish processors, importer/exporters, etc.

The system provides access to the origin of fish by importer and/or customs of importing country including consumers via the QR Code that come with the Catch Certificate and fish/fishery products.

The mobile application is uploaded to Google Play Store for Android and App Store for iOS (in 2019) as free application for registered stakeholders.







ASEAN Catch Documentation Scheme (ACDS)


SEAFDEC member countries expressed their support on the development of ACDS as a tool to prevent the entry of fish and fishery products from IUU fishing activities into the supply chain

KEY DATA ELEMENTS (KDEs)



1) Catch Declaration (CD)

- Port-out control, issue initial CD and password
- > Catch report at point of catch via mobile
- ➤ Port-in control, catch weight verification
- ➤ Issue the CD to fishing master

2) Movement Document (MD)

- > Fish purchasing process at the landing site
- Issue the MD either to local market or processor

3) Catch Certification (CC)

- ➤ Processor request for the CC via web-based application
- ➤ The Competent Authority issues the CC for exportation
- > The importer makes clearance on the CC

4) Processing Statement (PS)

Statement created by processing plant to confirm that the processed fishery products had been obtained from catches supplied or imported

5) Re-export Certificate (RC)

➤ Document intended for the convenience of any AMSs fish and fishery products which had been previously imported into the AMSs for re-exportation without processing
