1. OPENING A MEETING

- 1.1** The meeting on preparation of marine fisheries management area map in Kampot province was organized by Fisheries Administration (FiA) of Cambodia collaborating with Fisheries Administration Cantonment in Kampot on 25 August 2020, funded by SEAFDEC/UNEP/GEF Fisheries *Refugia*. The meeting was conducted at Prek Thnaot Commune, Tek Chhou District, Kampot province, which was attended by 15 participants in total from Fisheries Administration, Fisheries Administration Cantonment, Tek Chhou District, Prek Thnaot commune, and Community Fisheries (see **Annex 1, 2 & 3**).
- 1.2 Mr. Leng Sy Vann**, Deputy Director of Department of Fisheries Conservation welcomed all participants taking their chances to join the meeting today. The purpose of meeting today is to define the certain map of MFMA in Kampot province in order to ensure effective marine fisheries resource management, especially fisheries resource in Prek Thnaot area. The establishment of MFMA does not cover whole conservation area; it is covered about 10% of the whole area. Thus, the creation is very useful to ensure sustainable fisheries resource consume and management, especially resource in Prek Thnaot area. However, so far the map of MFMA has been suffered and overlapped from coastal area development project; it is needed to define clearly the boundary of coastal development area and MFMA. The meeting today is very important in contribution to providing information or location of the boundary of coastal development area from all participation, especially chief of local authorities and community fisheries.
- 1.3 Mr. Sar Sarin**, Director of Fisheries Administration Cantonment in Kampot expressed thanks very much for all participants. He informed that marine fisheries resource has been affect from coastal development and increasing in fishermen and MFMA creation plays a main role in enhance fish stock, ecotourism, and local livelihood as well. Nowadays, MFMA map is not clear and has been affected from coastal development area, so it is needed to define clearly boundary between coastal development project and MFMA. He proposed all participants especially local authorities and community fisheries help provide information or location of coastal development, it is easy to demarcate the boundary between coastal development and MFMA. Then he declared to open the meeting from now.

2. DISCUSSION ON DEMARCATION BEWTEEN COASTAL DEVELOPMENT AREA AND MFMA

- 2.1** The district and local authorizes as well community fisheries, especially FiAC in Kmapot supported the establishment of MFMA in Kampot province in order to enhance fish stock, eco-tourism, local livelihood, and improve ecology system as well
- 2.2** The meeting has demarcated between the boundary of coast development project and MFMA. Development Project of Try Pheap Tycoon is the size of 225ha (square rectangle=2.5km) and Ching Kor company is the size of 640ha. Thus the water area of MFMA (8486ha) has affected from coastal development project over 10%.
- 2.3** Ching Kor Company defined way points already, but Try Pheap Tycoon did not define way points yet. In that case, FiAC in Kampot need to work with Prek Thnaot commune and the representative of Tycoon' Try Pheap to set any day to collect way points. DFC/FiA will wait for working with FiAC, CFi, and Try Pheap's Tycoon representative to collect way points.
- 2.4** The meeting proposed coastal area development company to be needed to install buoys at the boundary clearly

3. CLOSURE OF A MEETING

- 3.1 Mr. Sar Sarin** informed the meeting that the establishment of MFMA is very important in sustainable marine fisheries resource. He proposed district and local authorizes, and

community fisheries participate and support in protection of marine fisheries resource in order to recover marine resources well. The meeting is closed at 4:00pm in delighted environment.
