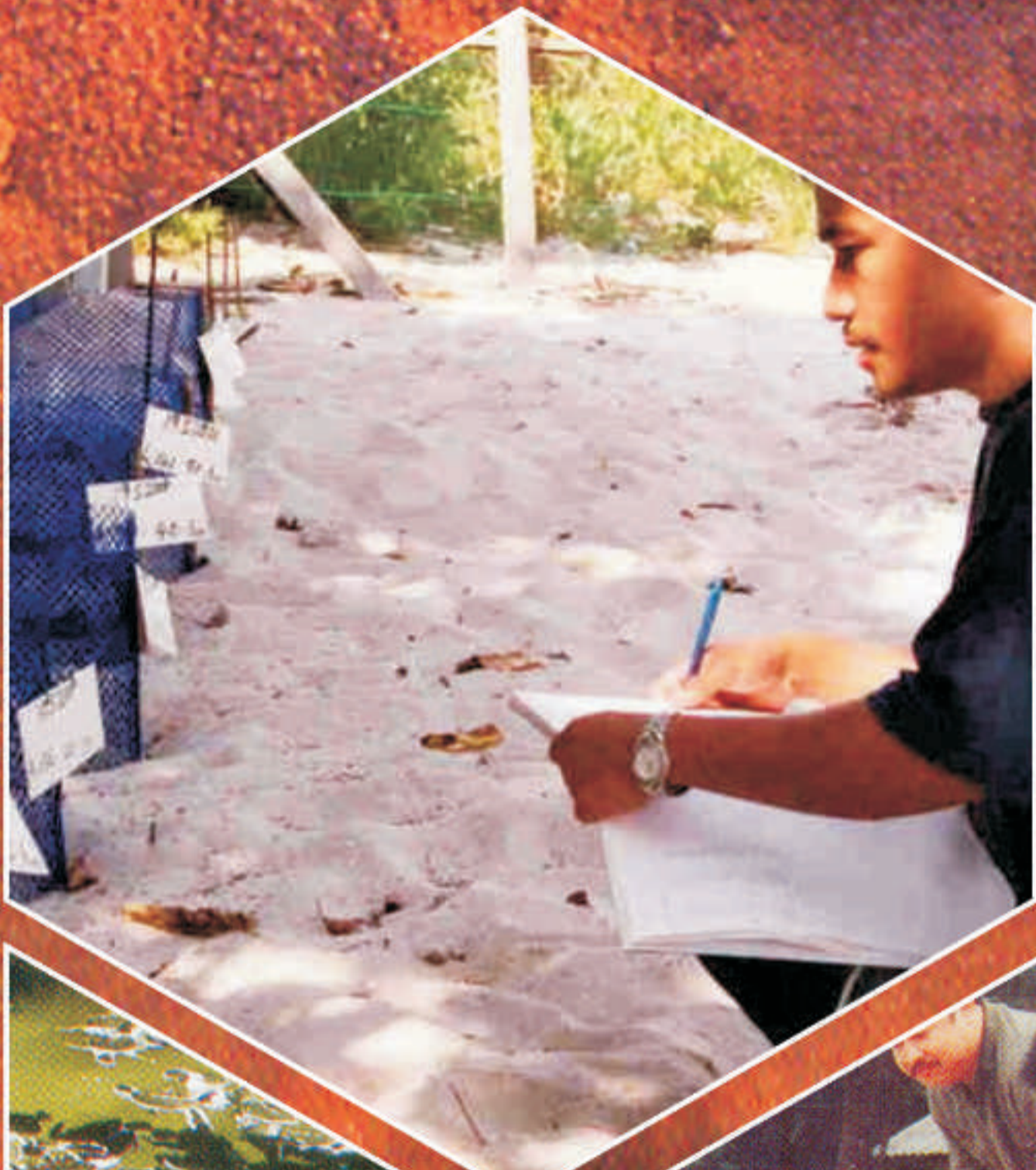
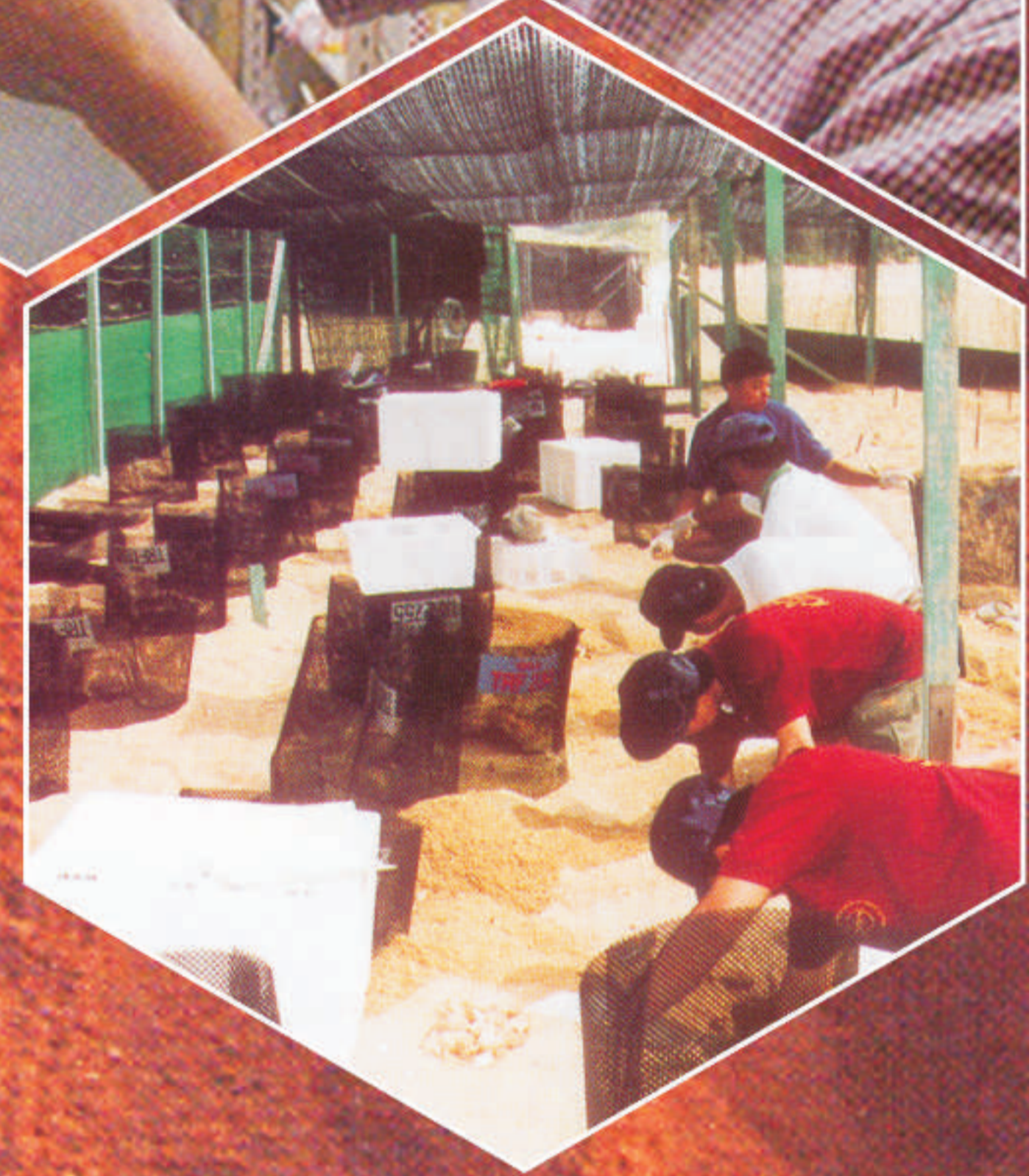
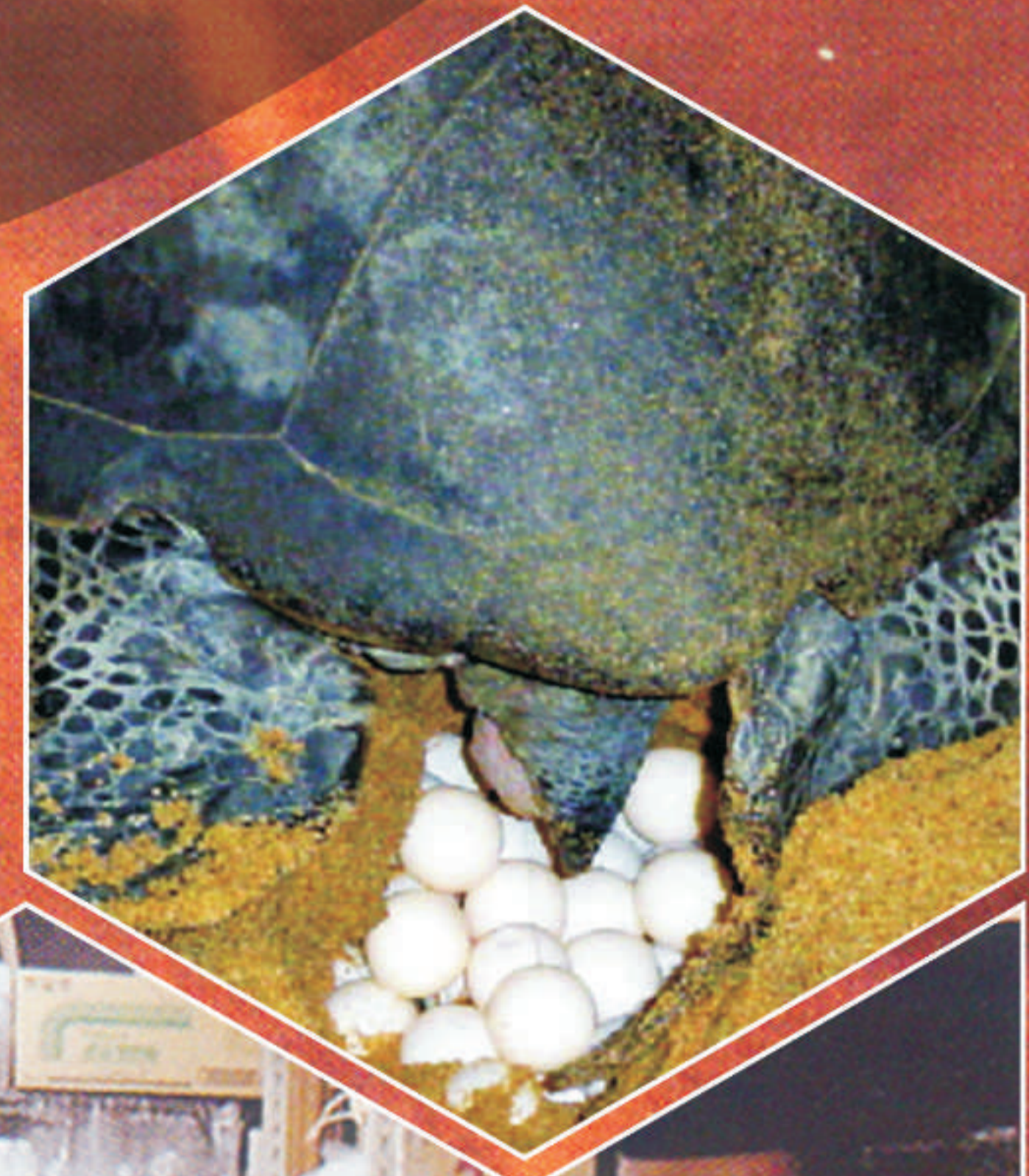


# SEA TURTLE CONSERVATION AND MANAGEMENT

Sea Turtle are important marine animals, not only under CITES agreement but also in the Southeast Asian region as traditional living resources. SEAFDEC has, within the regional approach, coordinated and compiled information as well as established mechanisms for regional collaboration on research, conservation and management, and enhancement activities of these animals in Southeast Asia.

Efforts have also been made to better understand the interaction between sea turtles and fishing activities while initiatives on reducing interactions and mortality due to fishing in the Southeast Asia have been promoted. These regional activities aim to supplement future development of conservation and management measures of the sea turtle.
