1. Field Trip Objective

- 1) To deploy and install mooring buoys at the boundary of mackerel refugia at Peam Krasob, Koh Kong province under funded by SEAFDEC/UNEP/GEF.

2. Involved Person

- 2) The field trip was attended by the teamwork from Department of Fisheries Conservation, Fisheries Administration collaborating with Koh Kong Fisheries Administration Cantonment, and the participants from Koh Kong Provincial Department of Agriculture, Forestry, and Fisheries, Mondol Sema and Koh Kong District Authorities, Peam Krasob and Koh Kapi Commune Authority, and Peam Krasob Community Fisheries were also present at that event (see Annex 1 and 3):

3. Field Trip Activities**3.1. Meeting with Koh Kong FiAC**

- 3) Teamwork from DFC/ FiA met and discussed with FiAC in Koh Kong on the plan preparation for mooring buoy installation and dissemination of closure notice of mackerel fishing at Peam Krasob site.
- 4) Regarding mooring buoy installation, it is agreed to select 9 points for deploying mooring buoy at the boundary of mackerel refugia site
- 5) As for the dissemination of the closure notice of fishing, the meeting agreed to provide that job to FiAC and Provincial Hall Administration to take action and prepare broadcasting this letter through social and local media.

3.2. Installation of Mooring Buoys at the Boundary of Mackerel Refugia at Peam Krasob

- 6) Teamwork from DFC/FiA collaborating with Koh Kong FiAC included participants from Koh Kong Provincial Department of Agriculture, Forestry, and Fisheries, Mondol Sema and Koh Kong District Authorities, Peam Krasob and Koh Kapi Commune Authority, and Peam Krasob Community Fisheries, who join the important events of mooring buoys installation at the boundary of mackerel refugia .
- 7) The mooring buoys were deployed at the location of 9 points, which was showed as below:
 - X= 282377 Y=1268254; X=281280 Y=1269992; X=279690 Y=1272269;
 - X=277268 Y=1271174; X=277813 Y=1270344; X=278294 Y=1269592;
 - X=278746 Y=1268905; X=279161 Y=1268570; and X=280372 Y=1267030

3.3. Dissemination of Provincial Hall Administration's Noticed Letter on Closed fishing of Mackerel at Peam Krasob

- 8) The noticed letter on closed fishing of mackerel at Peam Krasob starting on 01 December 2020 to 31 March 2021 has been issued by Provincial Hall Administration. The letter was been broadcasted by local radio, leaflet, and social media. The purpose of the dissemination is intended to inform fishers, local authority, and community fisheries to know about the duration of fishing close of mackerel starting from 1st December 2020 to 31st March 2021 because those months are the period of mackerel spawning. Thus, those fishermen can resume fishing when its closed season ends (See Annex 4).
