Highlights of Activities:

1. Upon the arrival on the first day, a courtesy call to the Municipal Mayor of Coron, Hon. Mario T. Reyes was conducted. We discussed the purpose of the visit as well as gave a list of proposed activities for Coron, Palawan in the first quarter of 2020.
2. On the second day, we started the at-sea mapping in the barangays near Coron bay such as Tagumpay, Guadalupe and Poblacion. The coordinates were recorded for the boundary delineation and further for the GIS mapping.
3. During the third day, we finalized the map by finishing at-sea mapping for the barangays Lajala, Banuang Daan and Borac.
4. During the duration of the activity, we were accompanied by a representative from the Community Environment and Natural Resources Office, Mr. Ryan Reyes.
5. Lastly, a sampling on the fish landing stations was also conducted together with the technical enumerators for verification of the data submissions for NSAP encoding.
