









WHAT'S ACDS?

ASEAN Catch Documentation Scheme (or ACDS) is one of fisheries management tools to improve traceability for marine capture fisheries and enhance intra-regional and international trade of the ASEAN Member States (AMSs).


The development of ACDS formed part of the ASEAN Guidelines for Preventing the Entry of Fish and Fishery Products from IUU Fishing Activities into the Supply Chain, adopted under the ASEAN Mechanism, and was led by Singapore as a ASEAN lead country since May 2014. Developed through a series of Regional Consultations, the ACDS was endorsed at the 25th ASEAN Sectoral Working Group on Fisheries (25ASWGFi) in May 2017 in Singapore. Subsequently, the ACDS concept was also supported by the SOM-AMAF in the same year. For the implementation of the ACDS by AMSs, it was suggested at several regional forums and stakeholder consultations in March 2016 that appropriate system of the ACDS is needed, both in electronic format and manual system to address the requirements of the SEAFDEC Member Countries.

Moreover, The SEAFDEC Council of Directors also sugguested that SEAFDEC should assure the appliability of the electronic ACDS system and ensure that it is beneficial to relevant stakeholders, e.g. operators of fishing vessels, suppliers, seafood processors for export, and traders.


eACDS

eACDS is a software for enhancing a traceability of fishery products through the ASEAN Catch Documentation Scheme. This eACDS software links all the elements in the supply chain from fishing, landing, processing, trade, to plate. The software generates certificates at each important supply chain such as

- 1) Catch Declaration (CD) from point of catch to landing;
- 2) Movement Document (MD) from landing to processors or local market;
- 3) Catch Certificate (CC) from processing to export/import and consumer via the QR-Code.

eACDS STRUCTURE


eACDS Software consists of two forms: 1) mobile application; and 2) web-based application.


- ► Mobile application is designed for:
 - a) Reporting at sea by Fishing Master and;
 - b) Fish purchasing and reporting by fish-buyer and processor at landing port.
- ➤ Web-based application is designed for:
 - a) Fishery officers to control the supply chain such as Port-out permission, Port-in permission, issuance of catch declaration, movement document, and catch certificate, etc.
 - b) Fish Processor to request for the Catch Certification online.

Both mobile and web applications are linked to the Hosting Cloud Server as a Government Data Center.


KEY DATA ELEMENTS

In order to enhance the effectiveness of the eACDS software, a unique eACDS database system which could be applied by all the ASEAN Member States has been developed. In this connection, many database modules such as fishing boat licenses, boat owner, fishing port information, HS Fishery Product Code, fish buyers, processors, import/exporter, among others are linked in the system.





9 STEPS OF eACDS



There are 9 steps of eACDS from origin of catch to plate:

- 1) Port-out permission and issuance of Initial Catch Declaration;
- 2) Catch reporting* at point of catch;
- 3) Port-in permission, catch verification and issuance of Catch Declaration (CD);
- 4) Fish purchasing at landing;
- 5) Issuance of Movement Document (MD) to fish buyers and/or processors
- 6) Requesting for Catch Certificate by processors
- 7) Issuance of Catch Certificate (CC) by Competent Authority;
- 8) Exporting;
- 9) Tracing fishery product from QR-Code by Importer, Customs and Consumers

^{*} Catch reporting at sea requires satellite communication system or mobile phone for near shore area. In case there is no such signal, user can use offline system until the device can detect a signal, then the data will be automatically transferred to the data center.




